

Once football gets in your blood, it remains forever.

Pat Lavin can tell you that.

Because he feels it.

He is enjoying the game as much as ever in his second tour of duty as head coach at Phoenix Bourgade Catholic.

The Golden Eagles finished the regular season with an 8-2 record, losing only to Yuma Catholic and Phoenix Arizona Lutheran but defeating perennial contender Phoenix Northwest Christian.

Lavin has been an Arizona coaching fixture for 40 years.

He took over the program at Phoenix St. Mary's from the legend who coached him there, Ed Doherty, and later coached at Avondale Agua Fria, Phoenix Paradise Valley and Glendale Independence. He also was head coach at Phoenix (junior) College and was an assistant at Northern Arizona University and the University of Minnesota.

He coached at Bourgade for eight seasons and then stepped back for awhile before returning to the sideline, where he is in his third season.

Bourgade was 2-8 in his first season and 4-7 last year.

"There were some struggles," he said. "You have to be disciplined and I think the kids want that, but it can take awhile. Now it is paying off. The sophomores back then are now juniors and seniors and they expect to be successful."

In other words, "Expectations Become Behavior." It is written on Lavin's business card and is a closing thought at the end of his e-mails.

The team's early success was due mainly because of its running game.

"This is the third year of the rebuilding effort and the players are buying into the higher "expectations," evidenced by their dedication in the weight room over the past two years," Lavin said.

"My staff and I would open the weight room at 6:30 a.m. and again after school. We constantly had a very good showing, especially by the seniors-to-be.

"In the past, we would have one or two players get into our "1,000' club. This year, we had 11 make it."

Bourgade has the ingredients to grind it out on the ground.

Senior running back Saul Rascon tied/set school records for the first four games of the season.

A few days into October, and the weather was still hot. Not triple digits, but in the mid-90s. More than hot enough for a football player to get a good sweat going in practice.

Goodyear Desert Edge wide receiver Elijah Marks headed to the sideline, took a few quick swigs of cool water and was ready for an interview.

He always seems to have a smile on his face, rain or shine.

There are plenty of reasons for Marks to smile these days.

The Scorpions went 10-0 during the regular season and are looking more and more like a team that is capable of returning to the Division III state championship game.

And Marks has had a lot to do with that.

The 6-foot-1, 180-pound senior has emerged as one of the top pass-catchers in the state. He chased several state season and career records in 2013.

"Last year, he was a basketball player playing football. This year, he is a football player," said Desert Edge coach Rich Wellbrock.

"He doesn't really look the part. You don't realize how fast he is, how strong, or how high he can jump until you see him on Friday nights."

Wellbrock recalled a recent game against Surprise Shadow Ridge where Marks ran a hitch near the sideline, caught the ball, broke one tackle, split three defenders and shook another tackler at the 5-yard line before scoring.

Marks played junior-varsity football as a sophomore and played basketball as some of his siblings did. He played varsity football last season, and felt more and more comfortable as the season went along. He worked a lot with quarterback Anthony Hernandez, a friend since early childhood.

"Playing wide receiver was a little difficult at first, but felt easier the more I played," Marks said. "I worked on reading defense, my footwork and running my routes."

This summer, Marks continued to improve when he played in passing competition at such places as UCLA, Arizona State, Surprise and Peoria Sunrise Mountain. He was working with Hernandez again.

"We've got really good chemistry," Marks said. "I have confidence that he is going to put the ball in a spot where I can catch it."

Scoring a touchdown, Marks said, "feels good. Nobody was able to catch you and now you're in the end zone. It puts a smile on your face."

He thinks the Scorpions have a good chance to go on another long run into the playoffs.

"We have a good offense and a good defense, too," he said. "Our offensive line has been blocking great, in the running game and the passing game. The other receivers (including Ismael Murphy-Richardson) have played well, too. They can get open, where the defense can't concentrate on covering any one guy."

Wellbrock said Marks already has scholarship offers from Idaho and New Mexico, and Marks hopes to see more by season's end. Then he will make a decision on his next step.

The 2012 state football champions in Divisions I through V were Hamilton, Ironwood Ridge, Queen Creek, Seton Catholic and Northwest Christian, respectively.

Looking at what's transpired in the 2013 regular season, I'd bank on new champs in all five divisions. Here's a look at the five divisions in a bit more detail:

DIVISION I: Favorite -- Mountain Pointe. Mountain Pointe fell a game short last year losing to Hamilton, but this year's Pride has displayed all the necessary elements -- varied offense, defense and plenty of speed on both sides of the ball. Mountain Pointe has been dominant all season. The one caveat the second half of the season is the lack of a challenge presented by what was thought to be a powerful section. Brophy and Desert Vista are not what they've been in recent years. Corona and Dobson struggled. The impressive wins over Hamilton and Chandler are the mark of how good MP is. Contenders -- Chandler. A beefed up schedule and 7-8 wins leaves the Wolves little to prove -- other than reaching and or winning the title. Defense seems to be as good as Chandler has seen it of late. That gives them a chance with their high-powered offense. Desert Ridge. Desert Ridge won a section that qualified at least four and maybe five teams for the tournament. The Jaguars have won defensive struggles and shootouts. Not sure they stand with Mountain Pointe and Chandler, but this might be their year to take Hamilton should they meet. Darkhorse -- Hamilton. Not the offense D-I is used to seeing from the Huskies. The defense hasn't been as stout as suspected at the outset. But Hamilton still managed eight wins in a tough schedule, winning four close games Liberty High (Henderson, Nev.), Basha and Highland. Defense dictates whether or not Huskies reach the semis or better.

DIVISION II: Favorite -- Salpointe. Not one letdown since the Lancers opened the season with Liberty High (Henderson, Nev.) on Aug. 24 to the end of the regular season. As high-powered as the offense is with Cameron Denson, Andy Cota and Kaley DeBoskie the Lancers defense has been equally impressive. If Salpointe is challenged in the tournament it won't be until the semis/finals. Contenders -- Chaparral. Only loss was via a shootout early with Marcos de Niza, but the Firebirds are better defensively and have knocked off some good D-I opponents (Red Mountain and Brophy) as well as one of D-III's best (Saguaro). D-II is full of potent offenses, but defense is where its at to win the big trophy. Centennial. Centennial took a beating from D-I Chandler early and has looked formidable since. That includes, like Chaparral, some solid wins over D-I opponents. Centennial has what it takes to win on both sides of the ball. The Coyotes eliminated Salpointe in the semis last year so they have that chip in the game. Darkhorses -- Mesquite, Sunnyslope and Campo Verde. All three face tough odds if or when they match up against Salpointe, Chaparral or Centennial. Mesquite has turned in an impressive turnaround from a two-win season to playing for the section title against Campo Verde in the season finale, albeit in D-II rather than D-I it competed in last year. The Wildcats have improved markedly as the season's worn on, a good sign. Sunnyslope won all its games, but faced one of the lighter schedules among D-II's elite. One or perhaps two of Sunnyslope's opponents will qualify for postseason. Those are near the 13-16 range of the bracket. That's the only knock against the Vikings, but a legitimate one. Campo Verde made the jump from D-III to D-II in impressive fashion. The Coyotes are good enough for a win or two in postseason, which would be the first in the school's brief five-year history.

DIVISION III: Favorite -- Saguaro. Saguaro gives up points, but they have a history of being high-scoring and winning shootouts when they take home a title. They've outscored two top section foes in Williams Field and Queen Creek and their only loss was to D-II rival Chaparral. Noone has found a way to stop or slow quarterback Luke Rubenzer. Considering he handles the ball on every play, that makes it tough to limit his touches short of ball-control keep-away. Contenders -- Desert Edge. Desert Edge is a little short on high-caliber competition. The same was true last year, but they showed everyone they could play with the best beating Saguaro and falling just short of Queen Creek. Desert Edge has a uber game-breaker in wide out Elijah Marks. If the hunger is there from last year's title-game loss, Scorpions can beat anyone in the tourney field as they've done to all to date. Williams Field. Williams Field would love to get another shot at Saguaro after spotting the Sabercats a 27-3 lead. Williams Field doesn't have that one standout threat, but several very good ones. The Black Hawks have a title-worthy squad. Darkhorse -- Queen Creek. Down a little offensively, down some defensively. If Bulldogs have a healthy backfield once the playoffs begin they are dangerous. They lost to both Williams Field and Saguaro during the season. Defense will have to be at top of its game to return to finals or perhaps even the semis.

DIVISION IV: Favorite -- Show Low. Randy Ricedorff's squad wasn't content with its usual White Mountain section schedule. So they added Queen Creek and Williams Field from D-III to the mix. They aren't worse for the wear even though they lost one of those. The competition helped set them up to drub both Snowflake and Blue Ridge in October. This appears to be Show Low's best team since 2010 when it last won a state title. Contenders -- Blue Ridge -- Like Show Low, Blue Ridge has two losses. One was to D-III Prescott, who nearly knocked off Desert Edge early in the season. The other was to Show Low. Blue Ridge looked sharp in its final three games tuning up for postseason. Not a stretch to see Blue Ridge play for or win the title. Snowflake. Snowflake is the only D-IV school to face Show Low, Blue Ridge and Seton this season. The Lobos were 1-2, defeating Seton in a tight game. There isn't much separating Snowflake from the other three. It may be a case of on any given Friday night..... Darkhorse -- Seton Catholic. Seton doesn't have as many of the high-caliber athletes as last year, but they've performed better than most teams that lose as many solid seniors as the the Sentinels did. Of all the division darkhorses, this is one that isn't a big stretch to come away with a title appearance/victory.

DIVISION V: Let's dispense with the favorite, contender, darkhorse talk here. This is the state's most wide open bracket with Yuma Catholic, Arizona Lutheran, Northwest Christian, Thatcher, Round Valley, Joy Christian and perhaps St. Johns capable of hoisting a championship trophy the day after Thanksgiving. First, none of the teams is unbeaten. Yuma Catholic has lost to Thatcher and beaten Arizona Lutheran, Bourgade and D-IV River Valley (top 5 in D-IV). Arizona Lutheran has defeated Joy Christian, NWC and Bourgade. Joy Christian has beaten Thatcher. Round Valley has defeated St. Johns. Bourgade has beaten NWC. You get the idea. Enjoy the heck out of this tournament. Should be great entertainment throughout.







Denson a Force for Salpointe

It is fitting that Cameron Denson will go from Tucson Salpointe Catholic to the University of Arizona on a football scholarship in the fall of 2014.

He already knows how to Bear Down.

The 6-foot-1, 180-pound senior wide receiver and defensive back is one of the most passionate athletes you will find, and he has the ability to go with it.

Salpointe coach Dennis Bene calls Denson “a good kid. He has been here four years. He came in as a young kid and is going out as a mature young man. He has matured in everything, including the classroom. He has definitely taken a leadership role.

“He plays with a lot of passion. Once he gets it going, he is difficult to stop. He has grown into a difference-maker.”

Denson, who also played a major role for Salpointe’s state-tournament basketball team, is ready for anything.

“I have a passion for the game, especially football. It is something I love to do. I am going to go out there and give it my all, try to make something happen.”

Denson accounted for more than 2,000 yards as a junior, including 1,026 rushing yards (18 touchdowns) and 37 receptions for 585 yards (two TDs), as well as excelling on kickoff and punt returns. He mainly will be a wide receiver, teaming with transfer Kaelin Deboskie to build a formidable pass-catching tandem.

Denson likely will line up pretty much anywhere and fill a role similar to the one the Arizona Cardinals envision this season for star Larry Fitzgerald, who will line up in several spots in order to get him the ball as much as possible.

“Having me line up inside or out, moving me around a lot. That’s fine with me,” Denson said.

“My biggest asset is getting the ball in my hands, doing something with it. I run good routes to get open and once I get the ball, I’d like to think I can create a big play at any given moment.”

Bene acknowledges that Denson is at his best after the catch, “but he also is a tremendous blocker for a receiver.”

Denson says he is a “lockdown corner” on defense. He had two interceptions last season and sometimes gets frustrated when teams don’t throw in his direction. He knows he has to consider it a measure of respect on the part of opponents.

“I think I get a good break on the ball,” he said.

Denson was a big part of Salpointe’s victory over Division I defending state champion Chandler Hamilton at a passing camp in San Diego. Hamilton had defeated the Lancers, a Division II team, in an earlier passing competition.



At 6-feet-4 and 185 pounds, Redmond Delmar casts a long, strong shadow as Monument Valley's quarterback.

Redmond's school is located in the Native American community of Kayenta, in northeast Arizona. Media tentacles unfortunately seldom reach that far on a regular basis, compared to those players and teams in the large metropolitan areas.

He is a versatile athlete, a welcome trait, especially for his position. He also plays basketball and pitches for the baseball team, where according to Monument Valley football coach Bryan Begay, his fastball reaches the upper 80s (mph).

His numbers suggest that he is more than capable of playing football at the collegiate level.

After three games of the 2013 season, Delmar had career totals of 404 completions out of 532 attempts for 4,767 yards with 59 TDs and 29 interceptions.

"He has worked very hard to get to this point, particularly over the last year," Begay said. "He wants to play college football and he has made a commitment to that."

"He has made a lot of improvement in his read progression, is more accurate and is great in terms of leadership. He'll say what he needs to say when he walks to the team, but he also leads by example. He is at the point of, 'Just follow me. I will show you the way.' "

Delmar is a 3.5 (grade-point average) student, and is following in the footsteps of his older brother, Jonathan, who was the team's quarterback from 2007-09.

"They are similar in ability. Redmond is taller and probably stronger. He sees things with a good overall perspective. He looks forward to playing in the big games, and that's what we have this week," Begay said.

Delmar respects Jonathan's ability.

"He taught me a lot of stuff, pretty much everything I know, from mechanics, reading defenses, how to manage the game," Redmond said.

Begay has been proactive over the years in helping his players and program improve and achieve greater notoriety. Part of that has come from having the Mustangs participate in summer passing competition. This summer, the team played all over the state, against many of the bigger schools, as well as in the San Diego area.

Delmar played very well.

"It really helped us out, learning what each other's strengths are, what we need to do to get better. We have started out the season pretty good, but there are still things we need to work on," Delmar said.

He enjoys being in a leadership role.

"I know everyone depends on me," he said. "I like being the one that people look up to."

As far as mechanics are concerned, he said, "I think I've gotten better, my release has gotten quicker."

The Mustangs sometimes employ a no-huddle offense, which Delmar says keeps opponents "on their heels."

River Valley High School's football team had a good season in 2012, reaching the Division IV quarterfinals.

The leaders on offense are quarterback Derrik Advocate and running back Brandon Long. Advocate is a dual threat and Long has surpassed the 1,000-yard mark for the third straight season.

The team usually looks to run the ball first. That is due to the development of the offensive line. There are three juniors up front, Staggs said, who took their lumps as sophomores but now are better off for the experience and learning how to play.







Football players like the Scottsdale Desert Mountain passing combination of quarterback Kyle Allen and receiver Mark Andrews just don't come around very often.

That's why fans have to enjoy watching them while they can.

Allen and Andrews don't have to worry about being distracted by the recruiting frenzy. They already have given their commitments, Allen to Texas A&M and Andrews to Oklahoma, so they are free and clear.

The 6-foot-2, 200-pound Allen and the 6-6, 220-pound Andrews are best friends. They hang out off the field and on the field know what each other is going to do, where they are going to be, almost before it happens.

Allen came to Desert Mountain as a wide-eyed freshman, but by the time his sophomore season rolled around, he was in the starting lineup and hasn't left since.

Andrews had not played Pop Warner or any other organized football when he came to Desert Mountain. He started from scratch. Soccer and basketball were his specialties.

As a sophomore, he burst on the scene with 58 catches for 1,038 yards and 10 touchdowns. As a junior, he soared into the stratosphere with 81 grabs for 1,494 yards and 21 TDs and was named Big Schools Player of the Year by azcentral.com.

"When you come in your first year, you just hope you make the (freshman) team. Then you start to gain confidence. That's what happened to me and Mark," Allen said. "Last year was great for us, and we want to try to be better this time."

Given Andrews' inexperience as a freshman, he said it is "humbling and shocking to me to reach this point, never having played a down before. I never expected this."

Desert Mountain coach Tony Tabor said that "with all of the hype, they have done a good job of handling it. They have known each other a long time. They are not just good football players – they are good kids."

They also are good students.

Allen's grade-point average is 3.9. He will graduate in December and enroll at Texas A&M shortly thereafter so he can participate in spring drills.

"Non-stop football. It will be sweet," Allen said.

Andrews carries a 3.5 GPA, and hopes for similar results at OU, where he will be watched in person by many family members who live in the state.

Andrews said one of Allen's strong points is the mental part of the game.

"I've never seen a guy be able to pick the game and a team apart like he can," Andrews said. "And when he throws, he just put the ball where it needs to be."

Allen's assessment of his own progress is "the little things like footwork, accuracy and reads."

Andrews said he has reached new levels "by working on my routes, making sure I'm going to be in the right place at the right time."

With the help of Allen and his teammates, Andrews has continued to gain confidence and maturity.

"I think that because of my size, some people might underestimate my speed," he said. "To be honest, I don't think anyone can catch me from behind."

Andrews also is the team's punter, and he carries a burden that few have to deal with. He is diabetic, often wearing an insulin pump and taking shots daily.

"It's something I have gotten used to," said Andrews, who played on the school's basketball team as a junior but is unsure whether he will play this winter.

Allen said Andrews "can be as good as he wants to be. He understands the nuances of the game. As a freshman, he had that raw size and speed, but he has become so much better . . . I have no doubt that he will be playing on Sundays (NFL)."

Tabor agrees, and adds that Allen "is right there with him."

It might be a bit difficult at first when the players move on to college.

"We'll keep in touch," Andrews said.

Texas A&M and Oklahoma are in separate conferences and likely would not play each other "unless it's a bowl game or something, like for the national championship," Andrews said with a smile.

"I have to admit, I am glad it (hectic recruiting pace) is over, but I will never take it for granted. There is only once in a lifetime when you experience something like this. I am grateful, and I know Kyle feels the same way."


