



# D-I Boys: A Title Rematch for Brophy-Hamilton? Evidence Makes Case for Finals Pairing

Last season Chandler and Sandra Day O'Connor stole the Division I boys soccer spotlight in a highly-entertaining final won by Chandler. Left out of the final were teams familiar with centerstage -- Brophy Prep and Hamilton. Are they primed to regain their footing in that regard over the next two weeks?

Possibly. Brophy is the D-I tournament's No. 1 seed and Hamilton is No. 3 as competition opens Wednesday (Feb. 3) at the sites of the high seeds. The Broncos and Huskies are two of only three teams among the top-10 seeds with winning records against other top-10 tourney seeds. Brophy was 3-0 during the season and Hamilton 5-1 in such matchups. No. 7 seed Highland is the other with a 4-1-1 mark. Hamilton and Brophy have met in the D-I final three of the last five years.

Six of the top-10 seeds (Pinnacle, Mesa High, Corona del Sol, Campo Verde, Chaparral and Ironwood) have one win or no wins vs. a top-10 seed. Overall there hasn't been a lot of cross play among the top 10 seeds in power-ranking matches or invitatorials. Five of the first-round matches are first meetings this season. Matchups to date and past prowess seem to point to Brophy and Hamilton as the favorites to reach the finals on Feb. 13, but last year's final between a No. 7 seed and a No. 9 seed shows nothing is a sure thing.

Here's a brief look at the top-10 seeds -- highest to lowest:

**No. 1 Brophy** (12-5-3): The Broncos did not lose a power-ranking match (11-0-1) and their blemish was a season-ending tie with Liberty. That followed a thrilling 3-2 win over No. 2 Pinnacle two days earlier. Brophy bowed in the semifinals last year to Chandler and graduated 15 seniors. Coach Noah Lewkowitz has seen a core of young players meld to contender status. Leading the way is sophomore Carter Clemmensen with 27 goals, including four hat tricks. Sam Fletcher is next with six goals and six assists and Sam Tolson has five goals and five assists. The defense is led by seniors Ethan Shacknai, Garrett Anson and keeper Nick Bruguglio and junior Brandon Theodorou. Marquee wins are over Pinnacle, Mesa and Ironwood.

**No. 2 Pinnacle** (20-2): Coach Brock Heykoop saw the good and bad of closing the Pioneers' regular season facing Brophy. Though Pinnacle lost, 3-2, Heykoop said his team needed a match against a high-powered foe to be ready for the level of competition ahead at state. Pinnacle's attack is led by senior Dan Malki with 31 goals and 11 assists. Sophomore Dylan Stevenson has 11 goals and seven assists and Matt Grimes is next with nine goals. The team's assists leader is Matt Bertocchi with 14. Captains Grimes and Gus Sevchik lead the defense and keepers Robby Kalna and Joaquin Rodriguez have combined for five shutouts. Pinnacle's only losses are to Brophy and Hamilton -- the Hamilton loss in the finals of the Arizona Soccer Showcase in late December. Pinnacle played only three matches against top-10 seeds at state.

**No. 3 Hamilton** (13-2-4): The Huskies have faced a lot of the top competition in the division with wins over Pinnacle, Corona del Sol, Highland, Campo Verde and Chaparral. Hamilton got an offensive lift this season with the arrival of Josh Drack, who has contributed mightily with 24 goals. The Huskies defense is led by junior Beto Vidana and keeper Alex Deahr, who has eight shutouts. Hamilton's game relies on technique and speed of play. It has played four teams in its half of the bracket - Pinnacle, Corona, Chandler and Highland.

**No. 4 Gilbert** (13-5): Defense has been the key factor in the

Tigers' success this season. Captains Luke Boudreau and Allaene Espinoza anchor the back. Nine of Gilbert's 13 wins are via shutout. Keeper Noah Rivera has credit for the seven shutouts with a 1.07 goals-allowed-average. Gilbert is 2-3 vs. top-10 tournament seeds. Gilbert's wins over top-10 seeds are Campo Verde and Chaparral and its losses are to Mesa, Highland and Ironwood.

**No. 5 Mesa** (11-3-1): The Jackrabbits have enjoyed a nice year despite returning only three starters. Defense and ball control are the staples. Mesa's three captains are defenders -- senior Issac Garcia and Brian Gomez and junior Josh Lagunas. Three keepers have split time this year after last year's only keeper graduated. Omar Callejas have done the bulk of the goal-tending and have five shutouts. Moises Durazo and Alex Salgado are the top scorers with six goals each. Jose Reyes leads in assists with five.

**No. 6 Corona del Sol** (14-4-1): The Aztecs 1-2 punch is arguably the best in D-I with John Rea (26 goals) and Ryan Flood (20 goals). Corona is a dangerous playoff team and thought by many to have a good chance at reaching the finals. Its defense will have to play better. The Aztecs open with defending champ Chandler, who defeated Corona 1-0 nearly two weeks ago. A quarterfinal rematch with Hamilton could loom if the Aztecs topple Chandler. The Aztecs have split two games with Hamilton, winning 3-2 and losing 4-2. Corona is 1-2-1 vs. top-10 tournament seeds (loss and tie with Camp Verde besides split with Hamilton).

**No. 7 Highland** (12-3-2): The Hawks have allowed the fewest goals of any D-I team (13). Keeper Jacob Faircloth has eight shutouts and defenders Chris Boyd, Peysen Webster, Hunter Peterson and Nathan Miller have been staunch in the back. Offensively the Hawks are led by Hunter Figueroa (14 goals) and Raphalello Colasito (8 goals). Highland's 4-1-1 record vs. top-10 tournament seeds reveals wins over Gilbert, Mesa, Campo Verde (2), a tie with Chaparral and a loss to Hamilton.

**No. 8 Campo Verde** (16-4-2): Climbing the ladder to D-I with its girls program hasn't been easy, but quite successful. Led by captains Luke Gleadle, Jonathan Zimmerman and Gary Taylor, the Coyotes were in the hunt for the section title down to the final week. Gleadle leads the attack with 18 goals and has five assists. The defense is the Coyotes' strength led by Jonathan Zimmerman, Trevor Devlin, Nathon Smith and keeper Justin Zimmerman. Justin Zimmerman has a .688 goals-against average). Campo Verde is on the short end of beating top-10 tournament seeds (1-4-1). The Coyotes lost to Highland twice, Gilbert and Hamilton (2-0). They own a win and tie with Corona del Sol.

**No. 9 Chaparral** (13-4-3): The Firebirds bolted from the gate with a 9-0-1 record that included winning the Bulldog Invitational hosted by Goldwater. Since then Chaparral is an even .500 (4-4-2) with the toughest part of its schedule coming from late December forward. Chaparral is 0-2-2 against top-10 tournament seeds. The ties are with Highland and Mesa and losses to Hamilton and Gilbert.

**No. 10 Ironwood** (10-4-1): The Eagles are in the playoffs for a third year in row, having bowed out last year to eventual champ Chandler and to eventual champ Brophy in 2014. Ironwood possesses good team speed that's explosive at times. James Holmes tops the goal-scoring chart with 19 and Carlos Avezcuco has six goals and 18 assists. The defense is led by senior center back Rogelio Guerrero and junior center back Gerardo Rodriguez.

# Xavier Seeks Atonement at 2016 Tourney

## Top-Seeded Gators Were 1-and-Done Last Season

Its seed is not uncommon. Xavier Prep is No. 1 as the 2016 Division I state soccer tournament unfolds Tuesday (Feb. 2) and culminates with the final on Saturday Feb. 13. The Gators have been the toughest team to score against in the division, have a lone loss to an Arizona school and a knack of playing deep into state tournaments, if not winning them.

Until a rare blip last year. That's when the third-ever, one-and-done at state took place for Gators. Xavier was the No. 2 seed and upset in the opening round by No. 15 Chandler High, which advanced to the semifinals before bowing out. That's not something Xavier need apologize for, but it's likely to have the Gators highly motivated this year. Xavier's other opening-round exits were in 1998 and 2006. Xavier has been no worse than a top-4 seed each of the last 10 years and No. 1 or 2 seven of those 10. Girls soccer has been sanctioned by the AIA since 1990.

Winning this year's tourney won't be easy despite Xavier's performance to date. No. 2 Perry and No. 3 Desert Vista have been pretty darn good, too. Perry reached the D-I final in 2014 losing to Pinnacle so the Pumas would love another crack at a title. Ditto Desert Vista, which has lost in the finals two of the last four years, including last year. A good bet would be a Xavier-Perry or Xavier-Desert Vista matchup in this year's final. However, there's always an unexpected result or two along the way. This year should be no different.

Here's a brief look at the top 10 teams by seed -- highest to lowest:

**No. 1 Xavier** (14-2-3): The Gators haven't worn out the scoreboard compared to some other qualifiers, but the eight goals allowed in 19 matches is tops. As a team they have 10 shutouts. Defense is anchored by juniors Elena Zurek, Katie Moore and Madie Amavilah and sophomore Madeline Warren. Sophomore keeper Kinsey Ehmann has registered 10 shutouts. Xavier's leading scorer is sophomore Nicole Hook (eight goals) followed by Emily Chiap (6) and Alexis Allard (5). Three of Allard's goals have been game-winners and she leads the team in assists with 10. Xavier routinely plays in the prestigious Excalibur Invitational in California and enjoyed its best finish there (fourth) this season. Xavier posted a 6-1 record vs. top-10 tournament seeds.

**No. 2 Perry** (17-2-2): The Pumas are young with six sophomores starting and have scored a bunch (73 goals). Hard to concentrate on one or two players as six have scored between five and 13 goals for the year. Many of those goals were tallied in invitationals in December. Leading the way are senior Kambree Meskill (13 goals), sophomore Amanda Dahl (11) and junior Kelly Cannistra (10). Meskill has 12 assists and Dahl has 11. Perry boasts a 5-2-1 record against the top-10 tournament seeds. All eight schools in its section qualified for state and four of its seven section matches were decided by one goal.

**No. 3 Desert Vista** (17-3-1): The Thunder didn't win their section, but managed to hand section-champ Perry its only section loss, 2-1. Defense has always been the keystone of coach Marvin Hypolite's teams at DV. This year is no exception as the Thunder have given up only 11 goals. Keeper Kamrie Gunderson has turned in nine shutouts and is helped in the back by Jessica Hale and Lauren Schooler. Desert Vista will need others to pick up the defense with the loss of two senior captains to suspension last week. Three players have scored in double digits for the season -- Paige Maling (14), Tatum Heering (12) and Olive Jones (10). In matches against teams seeded in the top 10 this season Desert Vista is a lofty 9-2-1.

**No. 4 Hamilton** (15-3-2): The Huskies offensive leader is sophomore Brianna Atterbury, who has 20 goals and eight assists. But it's

defense that has paved the way to another solid season. Junior keeper Luz Galindo has 12 shutouts. Hamilton was 4-3-1 against top-10 tournament seeds. Hamilton has faced six of the seven teams in its half of the state bracket this season with a 5-0-1 mark. None of those teams (Gilbert, Pinnacle, Highland, Campo Verde, Corona del Sol and Red Mountain) scored against them. Hamilton didn't play top-seed Xavier.

**No. 5 Pinnacle** (11-6-1): The Pioneers season was boosted with transfer of two-time Gatorade Player of the Year Kelsey Turnbow from Washington. Turnbow has scored 23 goals and is the focal point of the offense. Defensively Pinnacle is led by Sarah Loy, Carly Goehring and Adrianna Rodriguez. Pinnacle didn't fare well against top-10 tournament teams this season with a 2-4-1 record. Three of those matches were against No. 6 Chaparral (1-1-1). Pinnacle lost to Xavier, Hamilton and Corona del Sol -- teams in its half of the bracket.

**No. 6 Chaparral** (14-3-2): The Firebirds are another squad that wins with defense. They've allowed only 11 goals this season with six coming in losses to Xavier (3-0) and Pinnacle (3-2). Senior Allison Jorden leads in scoring with eight goals followed by seniors Sophia Struckman and Alicia Jamison with seven goals apiece. Freshman Emma Carlson has a team-high eight assists. Defense is led by juniors Chloe Christakos and Rachel Brown. Chaparral posted a 3-2-1 record against top-10 tournament teams. The wins were against Desert Mountain, Pinnacle and Corona del Sol.

**No. 7 Desert Mountain** (12-5-3): The Wolves were the No. 1 seed last year and have bounced back with a solid season with new coach Mark Eggleston taking over for Brad Keller. A pair of sophomores fuel the attack. Delaney Rohde and Ashley Valdivieso have scored nine goals each. Valdivieso is the top returning scorer after a 10-goal, freshman campaign. Goalkeeper Sophia Lettieri has logged seven shutouts this season. All five of Desert Mountain's losses have come vs. the top six seeds in the tournament -- Xavier, Desert Vista (2), Pinnacle and Chaparral. The Wolves played Perry to a tie.

**No. 8 Campo Verde** (10-7-3): An impressive resume for the Coyotes in a short time. They won the D-III title in 2013. Qualified for postseason each of the two years in D-II (finishing runner-up to Notre Dame last season). Earning a top-8 seed in a D-I debut is impressive. Top offensive players are Ali Turk (6 goals, 3 assists) and Emily Lynch (4 goals, 6 assists).

# Div. II Boys Soccer Preview

**No. 1 Rincon/University** (17-3, 12-0) State Championships: 1997, 1998 and 2007: Head coach Roxanne Taylor has 411 career wins (30 years) with three of those being state championships. The Rangers return to the playoffs for the first time in two years and they are returning as the top seed. MF Chris Cooper leads the team in scoring with 24 goals but Taylor points out he is just one part of her offense, "The team has wonderful chemistry this year and, although we have Chris Cooper scoring many goals, the rest of the team is responsible for 34 other goals pretty well divided among the entire team. You can't just man mark one of our players because 10 others players can score." The Rangers also have 10 shutouts and there are 12 seniors on the team.

**No. 2 Tucson** (21-0-1, 10-0-1) State Championship: 2014: The Badgers have only lost three games since 2013, an incredible run by head coach Ismael Arce. The team has made a statement by beating Rincon twice in invitational play this year with team captain Julian Gaona leading the way with 36 goals and 14 assists. 15 seniors means leadership is the key for Arce, "Most of my team consists of seniors. We strive to play as a team and we support each other as a family." The team set a goal to go undefeated as they did in 2014 when they won the championship. Gaona is a father with a baby born in November.

**No. 3 Gila Ridge** (12-2-1, 9-2-1) First playoff appearance: Not only is this the first playoff appearance for the Hawks, it's the first winning season since the program began eight years ago. First-year coach Corey Semler credits a change in culture and having all of his players available for the change including senior CB Shae Erickson, "Erickson is probably our MVP thus far. He is the anchor of the defense and has led our team to seven shutouts." Traybourne North leads the team in scoring but the program can score in many ways according to Semler.

**No. 4 Kofa** (11-5, 9-3) State Championships: 1983 and 1989: Head coach Jamie Nicewander lists F Angel Lopez (17 goals), F Gavin Nicewander (16 goals) and MF Cristian Villegas (15 goals as

his leaders, "We have been successful because of a team defend, team attack mentality. Notice we have four players who have scored over 10 goals each. The wealth is spread. Our back line has been the same. We have rotated defenders often and tried to build a deeper bench for post season play."

**No. 5 San Luis** (9-3, 9-3) Second place in 2006 and 2015: "New" head coach Tim Conroy led the team to a second place finish in 2006 and was an assistant on last year's runner-up team. "Our leading scorer this year is senior midfielder, Christian Trujillo with nine goals in 11 games, three of which were game-winning goals." The Sidewinders only have one returning starter, GK Romel Ojeda.

**No. 6 Cibola** (11-4-2, 7-3-2) Two playoff appearances in seven years: First-year coach Bryan Claudio has led the Raiders one of the most successful seasons in school history. MF Gabriel Claudio leads the team with 14 goals and MF Enrique Zamora has added 8. The team started the season out 5-0 and ended it with a 4-0-1 streak.

**No. 7 South Mountain** (13-3, 10-2) Top seed in 2013: The Jaguars have struggled since reaching the quarterfinal round in 2013 but first-year coach Jose Diaz has the team back in the playoffs. Leading the way is F Bryan Medina and his 29 goals. Medina is ranked seventh in the state for goal scoring but the team also sports STRK Angel Torres (16) and MF Bryan Aceves (12).

**No. 8 Trevor Browne** (17-3-1, 9-2-1) Playoffs three years in a row: Jeffrey Scofield has led the Bruins to three straight playoff appearances but this is the first in Division II and the first time the team is hosting a playoff game. F Victor Perez is the leading scorer. Team captains are GK Oswaldo Machado and MF Isaac Pedraza.

**No. 9 Sunnyslope** (12-6-1, 9-2-1) Second place finish in 1989: First-year coach Mike Fenton has benefitted from the play of MF Sebastian Arellano who currently leads the team with 19 goals but he also credits the defense of John Kanner, Junior Gonzalez, David Gonzalez, Manuel Jacobo and Cain Guevara for keeping the team in games.

**No. 10 Canyon del Oro** (11-6-2, 8-2-2) State Championships: 2009 and 2010: Jake Gillengerten is in his second year with the Dorados. CDO has not lost at home in two years. Due to injuries, the team played four high-profile matches with only 10 to 12 players on the roster. Dario Contreras leads the team with 10 goals.

**No. 11 Nogales** (11-7-1, 8-3-1) Third seed in 2015: Armando Romero-Davis is in his second year with the Apaches. Nogales was seeded third last year and made it to the quarterfinal round. The Apaches finished this year with six wins in a row with GK Jose Armentilla credited with keeping the team alive on defense. Joaquin Ramos is the team leader.

**No. 12 North Canyon** (10-1-1, 10-1-1) Quarterfinals in 2015: Kelvin William Reece has posted his second 10-win season in a row. STRK Slobodan Kajtaz has 22 goals to lead the Rattlers.

**No. 13 Carl Hayden** (10-3, 8-3) Second place finish in 2010: First-year coach Michael Varela has almost matched the victory total for the last two years combined. "We are a team that focuses on dedication to team and family. We regularly meet as a team for team breakfasts and lunches. The group of guys on this team believe in selfless service and dedication to each other and that is what makes us strong as a team. This is my first year running the program so we are trying to build consistency in the program."

**No. 14 Greenway** (10-3-1, 9-3) Second Place: 1984, 1985, 1989 and 1990: Ken Laird is leading the Demons to their best record since a semifinal finish in 2013.

**No. 15 Arcadia** (9-2-1, 9-2-1) Second place in 2007: Michael Van Ess is in his second year with the program. The team lost their first game of the season and the last. "(We are a) very unselfish team, extremely young 6 of our 11 starters are underclassmen and willing to learn and want to get better," Van Ess wrote. Sebastian Gutierrez and Francisco Campos have 10 goals each.

**No. 16 Higley** (10-7, 9-3) Section champion: The Knights won their last five games to make it to the playoffs by winning Section IV. The team also outscored opponents 22-5 in that span.






