MAKE YOURSELF AT HOME: LEADING EDGE QUICKLY ADAPTED TO 1A

One of Arizona's small school basketball forces went down, but by no means is it out.

Leading Edge Academy-Gilbert relocated from the 2A to 1A Conference this season. Even with the move, it can still contend for the 2A title and give 4, 5 and 6A teams a game in the playoffs this month.

The Lady Spartans conquered 5A Campo Verde in late February and battled with 6A, top-10 ranked Perry until Perry's depth wore Leading Edge down in the third quarter in mid February. But don't expect the 1A tournament to be a cakewalk for the Spartans.

Leading Edge joined a 1A Conference with teams that can also play ball. But Leading Edge, after completing its first 1A regular season, left no doubt that it's the favorite once the tournament begins March 6.

The No. 1 seed finished its first 1A foray with a 16-1 regular season record. The coach of the team is the architect of Leading Edge's basketball program, Erik Gray, now in his 12th season as the coach.

Since moving to the Arizona Interscholastic Association, Gray's Spartans are 48-1 in region and have captured one 2A title and a 2A runner-up. Gray is also his school's athletic director.

"Basketball is 100 percent my passion," said Gray, a native of basketball hotbed North Carolina. "It's been good to me and my family, and I've enjoyed it for the past 12 years."

Gray actually played soccer in college before coaching the other sport that tugs at his heart.

When he moved to Arizona, he played for a coach who became a mentor, Campo Verde's soccer coach Andrew Guarneri. Guarneri was coaching at Chandler-Gilbert Community College when Gray played for him.

Like Guarneri, Gray doesn't need to raise his voice to motivate his teams. This year's Leading Edge team is determined to not stumble like it did in the playoffs last year and send its seniors out as champions.

Leading Edge lost in the first round of the 2020 2A playoffs to a lower seeded team, which Leading Edge defeated by 23 points in the regular season.

"We talk about it all the time," Gray said. "We can't overlook anyone."

Gray sees a lot of similarities between this year's postseason hunger and Leading Edge's 2018 championship run.

In 2017, Gray's girls also faltered unexpectedly at state before bouncing back the following season. This year's seniors will play a big role in how the final chapter of their high school careers end.

Leading Edge senior Brionna Smith will be priority No. 1 for potential playoff opponents. Smith is very athletic and leads the 1A in scoring and hand claps from fans when the 6-1 forward goes coast-to-coast.

The senior is taking her exploits to Park University in Gilbert after this season. Smith will attract attention, but the other Smith

on the team, Morgan, can also put on a show.

Besides her shooting acumen from the outside, Morgan, a forward, is also a great defender. The Smiths aren't related, but they do share a strong bond along with the other seniors on the team, Audrey Cobos, Alayzah Johnson and Amber Thorson (6.9 ppg).

Leading Edge will be at full force come playoff time, as its starting point guard, the cool and collected Talia Estrada, will return after nursing a sore back and sprained wrist this season.

"They always play hard," said Gray about his squad. "They always seem to step up to the competition. When it's time to buckle down and play hard, it's all grit and grind."

"We are trying to turn a sour note into a positive after losing in the playoffs last year and dealing with this year's challenges. And we want to do it for the seniors."

One of the 1A coaches who welcomed Leading Edge into the conference with open arms also guides a contender.

Gray sought the advice of Fort Thomas' athletic director/coach Lee Haws as Gray's Spartans were moving to 1A. Both teams played in the regular season, with Leading Edge winning 57-43.

The only other loss Fort Thomas (16-2) suffered this season came to 2A contender Pima.

"Fort Thomas moves the ball well offensively," Gray said.

"They are good at finding the gaps. (Haws') guards are really good and athletic. They have gotten better since we played them, and they have a great coach. His phone is always open."

Fort Thomas lost to the eventual 2020 state champ, Rock Point, in the state semifinals last year.

But due to the pandemic, Rock Point and Baboquivari, the 1A state runner-up the past three seasons, didn't dress this year. Also, because of the pandemic, the 1A high seeds will get to host the first two rounds of state. Prescott usually hosts all of the 1A's games annually.

Gray welcomed the move. After 12 years at the helm, this will be the first time that Gray and Leading Edge will get to host a game or two since becoming an AIA member.

But Leading Edge wouldn't mind if its season ends elsewhere. The 1A championship site hasn't been posted yet.

But we are pretty sure all of the 1A teams have already circled the date of the championship game -- March 16.

"We talk about ending on a high note and staying healthy," Gray said. "We talk about making good choices and not going out to hang out with a bunch of people and being smart."

"We know we have talent and skill, but it will also take some luck and staying healthy."

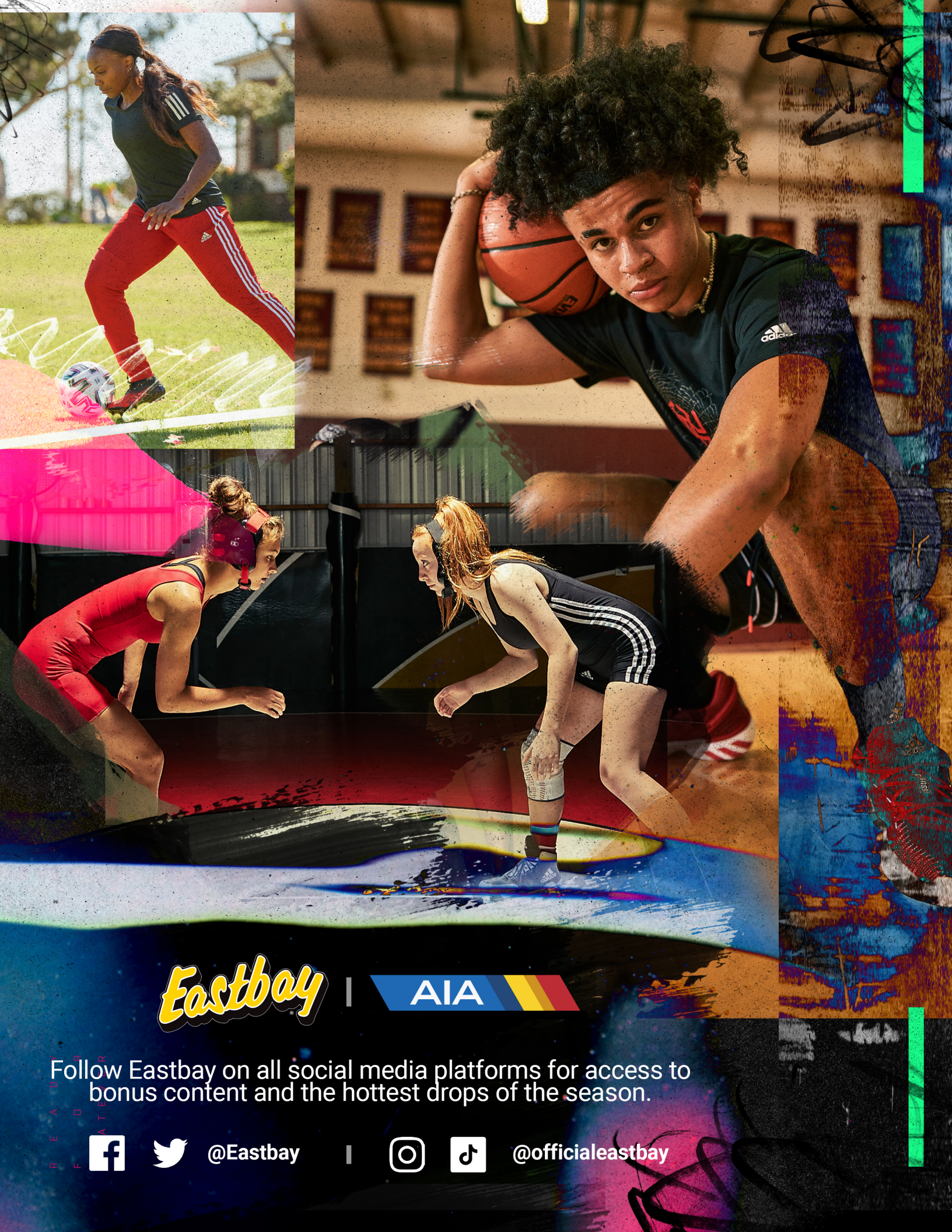

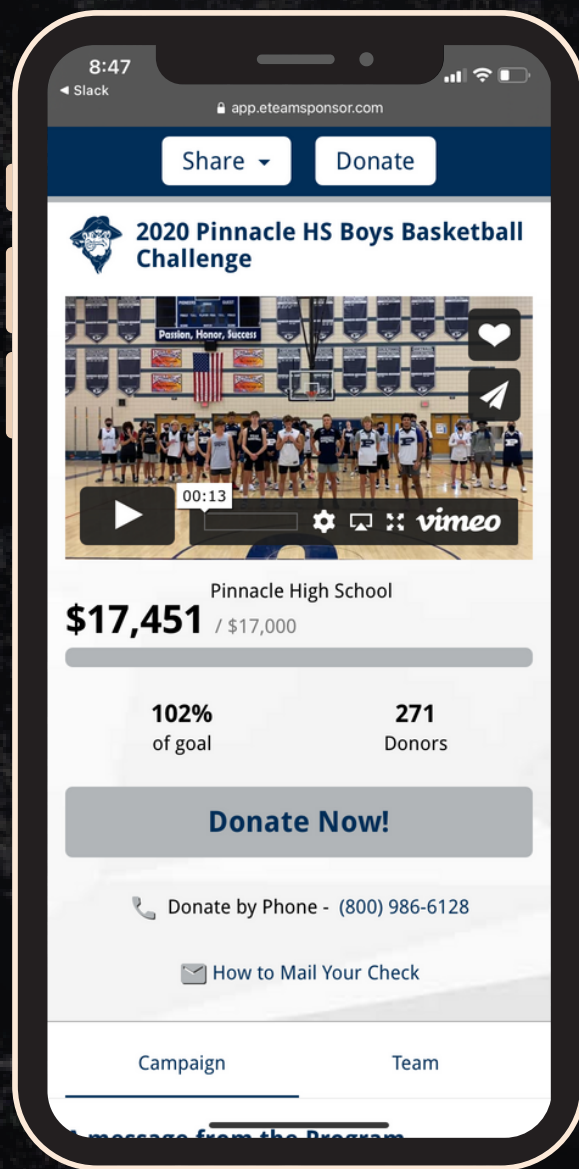

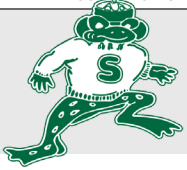
