# VALLEY VISTA, HAMILTON HAVE SHOT AT 6A GIRLS HOOPS TITLE REMATCH

For several weeks now it's been arguably apparent the four best teams in 6A girls basketball are Hamilton, Valley Vista, Xavier Prep and Perry.

With the bracket release, however, only three of the four have a chance to reach the semifinals. Perry ended up a slot lower after losing its final regular season game to remove the possibility of all four reaching the semis. That's no disrespect to Dobson, Westwood Mesa High and Highland, who have produced competitive, successful seasons. So prepare for a championship come March 20 featuring Hamilton or Perry against Valley Vista or Xavier. It's going to be that simple.

- #9 Sandra Day O'Connor (12-4) at #8 Perry (12-5)
- #12 Desert Vista (12-4) at #5 Westwood (15-3)
- #13 Desert Ridge (13-5) at #4 Dobson (13-2)
- #14 Tucson (8-5) at #3 Xavier Prep (11-3)
- #11 Pinnacle (12-6) at #6 Mesa (12-4)
- #10 Rincon (11-3) at #7 Highland (14-1)
- #15 Boulder Creek (9-7) at #2 Valley Vista (13-1)

The aforementioned four teams at a glance for the tournament that begins Tuesday March 9:

#1 Hamilton earned its seed with a 16-1 record. The Huskies have won 10 games in a row since their only loss to Perry. They've knocked off Valley Vista, Perry, Xavier Prep twice and Mesa teams ranked in the top eight. They also locked up last week with 4A No. 1 Seton Catholic and won with a late run in the final quarter in highly-anticipated matchup.

#2 Valley Vista has won three of the last four 6A titles. The Monsoon enjoyed playing an improved schedule with substitute games for three region foes who had their seasons cancelled due to COVID-19. Their schedule was front-loaded with the likes of Xavier, biggest rival 5A Millennium, Westwood and 4A top 4 Mesquite. They won all those games and lone loss was to Hamilton. The schedule has lightened up the second half, but with no signs of letdown as evidenced by its 10-game winning streak.

#3 Xavier Prep started a little slow breaking in a couple of freshmen in its starting lineup. It didn't help the opening games were against Valley Vista and Hamilton. The Gators posted an 11-3 record, beat Perry twice in an 11-1 finish. Xavier's starting lineup consists of a senior, two sophomores and two freshmen.

#8 Perry's second loss to Xavier to end the season (a buzzer beater) dropped the Pumas to the same bracket with Hamilton. If Hamilton and Perry win first round games as expected they will meet in the quarterfinals. The good note for Perry is it split two games with its top region rival. Perry had four players who started last year transfer to various programs. That left several new faces joining two returning players and they took time to meld. Perry (12-5) opened the season 4-4 and had its eight-game win streak stopped last Friday.

#4 Dobson, #5 Westwood, #6 Mesa and #7 are likely to win first-round games. The best opportunity to reach the semifinals should fall to Dobson or Westwood.

# NO. 1 RANKING ISN'T WHAT CASTEEL IS CHASING

Whatever they were feeding the Casteel High School winter student athletes at home or at the school's cafeteria during the pandemic, keep doing so.

The Colts have owned this winter season in the 5A Conference. Boys wrestling and girls and boys soccer are the top-ranked teams heading into their respective state tournaments.

Add one more to the herd of Colts winter No. 1's—girls basketball. Coach Daniel Trageser and his team welcome the target.

"We embrace the No. 1," he said. "Our kids love to compete."

Pardon for saying it, but Trageser's kids are also peeved. Not as much as they were last year at this point. But they are a highly motivated bunch after faltering in the 2020 state quarterfinals.

That's not where the Colts were expecting to finish. Not after a state semifinal run two years ago.

After last year's early exit, a 47-44 loss to Sunrise Mountain, a steady stream of tears hit the locker room floor from every team member except two, then juniors Daeja Johnson and Autymn Franks.

"I asked them if they were OK," Trageser said. "They were just stone faced for several minutes after losing. They just looked at us and said, 'We can't repeat this. This isn't happening. We are not going to feel this again.'"

Johnson and Franks are one of the state's top backcourt tandems.

Combined, they've played close to 200 varsity games. But they don't have a title to show for yet.

So they feel like they are long overdue for a gold ball. Johnson sets the tone on and off the court with her work ethic.

The 3.9 GPA student recently committed to Colorado State-Pueblo and is the school's career leading scorer with 1,300-plus points. Matching up with the 5-9 Johnson, a guard, is a task, and good luck trying to keep her from rebounding.

Against Casteel, opponents must protect the ball or Franks will swipe it away any chance she gets. She's also the second scoring option on offense.

The dynamic duo of Johnson and Franks are best friends and have shared the court since 7th grade. They also share the basketball.

The third threat on the team is junior forward Rayn Holton, who stepped up this year right from the start, posting a triple-double in her first game.

"She's 5-7 but plays like she's 6-2, 6-3," Trageser said. "She has a lot of putbacks and is a just a great athlete."

When Johnson or Franks drive and kick out they usually go to Camilla Norton, a senior leading the team in threes made and shooting 40 percent beyond the arc.

Casteel (16-0) added some depth this year with the transfers of Grace Oken (37 points in the last two games) and junior guard Jaleah Hendrix.

"They love playing with each other," said Trageser about his team. "It's one of the more connected groups I've coached. They've embraced each other and took in the transfers. It's all about the team."

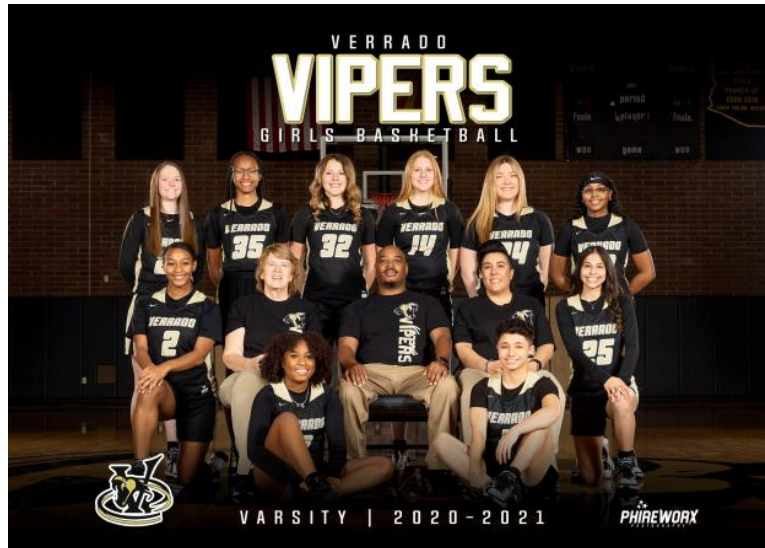

# WHO CAN CHALLENGE SETON CATHOLIC, THE QUEENS OF 4A?

Karen Self has 11 state championships and five runner-up finishes to her name dating back to 1996. More recently, the longtime Seton Catholic coach won eight of the last 11 state championships, including four of the last five. And 2013 was the last time the Sentinels failed to reach the final game. Shadow Mountain won it all in 2019 but Seton came right back and beat Sahuaro to win the championship last year. The Sentinels are to top seed this year with a 16-1 record with that loss coming to 6A Hamilton.

The games are played for a reason and there are a few teams within striking distance of Seton Catholic including Sahuaro and their senior standout Alyssa Brown. Brown is only 8 points away from being only the second girls from Arizona to score over 2,600 points in a career and 19 away from the second spot on that career list:

## No. 1 Seton Catholic (16-1) vs. No. 16 Paradise Honors (11-6)

Sr. G Amanda Barcello (14.8 points a game), Jr. Lexi McNabb (13.2), Jr. Sasha Daniel (10.4), So. Amelie Cartagena (8.1) and Sr. Bella DiGiovanni (7.5) are leading the Sentinels. Barcello is headed to BYU and DiGiovanni to Dartmouth. Paradise Honors lost in the 3A quarterfinals last year. F. G Nakyah Williams (14.1) leads the Panthers.

## No. 2 Salpointe (15-1) vs. No. 15 Desert Edge (10-5)

The Lancers lost in the quarterfinal round last year but with the high super seed the program is hoping to host the first three rounds this year. The only setback on the schedule was a loss at Sahuaro but the Lancers avenged that loss to end the regular season. Sr. Jaya Nelson leads the Lancers with 13.8 points a game. The Scorpions lost in the first round last year but the team ended this year with three straight wins. Sr. Haley Montano has 17.4 points a game.

## No. 3 Sahuaro (15-1) vs. No. 14 Thunderbird (13-4)

The Cougars held the top spot in the 4A Conference for a couple of weeks this year after starting out 14-0. The team took second last year behind the play of Gatorade Player of the Year Alyssa Brown. Brown is averaging 31.1 points a game this year. The Chiefs have four seniors on their roster and this will be the first state playoff game in two years for the program.

## No. 4 Mesquite (13-4) vs. No. 13 Poston Butte (13-5)

The Wildcats lost in the quarterfinals to Sahuaro last year and the team dropped two games to Seton Catholic this year. Sr. G Alaya Fitzgerald is scoring 22.4 points an outing

for the Wildcats. The Broncos lost in the play-in bracket last year but won their last four games to secure a spot in the playoffs this year. Poston Butte lost to Mesquite in February. So. Adriana Bachman has 13.9 points a game.

## No. 5 Notre Dame Prep (15-2) vs. No. 12 Combs (13-3)

The Saints played in the 5A Conference last year and did not make the playoffs. Notre Dame Prep has losses to play-off teams Deer Valley and Seton Catholic but the team won the West Valley Region. Sr. F Alivia Pautz has 17.1 points a game for the Saints. The Coyotes did not make the playoffs last year. Sr. G Theresa de la Cruz has 132. Points an outing.

ALA Queen Creek made it to the 3A quarterfinals last year and the team started this year out 2-6 before finishing with three wins. Sr. G Morgan Christensen has 16.5 points a game.

## No. 7 Deer Valley (14-2) vs. No 10 Pueblo (9-5)

Deer Valley lost in the first round last year and a close 35-33 loss to Notre Dame Prep to end the regular season put an end to a 12-game win streak. S. PG Rickelle Andrade has 10.8 points a game. The Warriors jumped from No. 30 last year to No. 10 this winter with So. F Victoria Cazares leading the way with 17 points a game.

## No. 8 Estrella Foothills (13-2) vs. No. 9 Coconino (11-3)

The Wolves lost in the first round of the state playoffs last year but went 10-0 to win the Southwest Region this winter. Sr. W Kennedy Harper has 17.5 points a game to lead the Wolves. The Panthers also lost in the first round last year so one team will make it to the quarterfinals. Sr. G Kiana Manuelito has 16 points a game for Coconino.

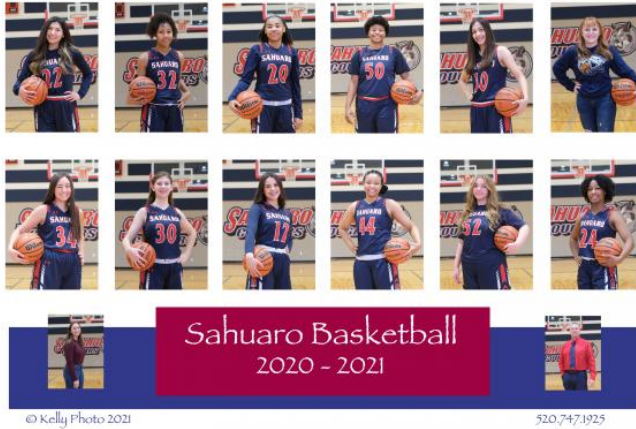

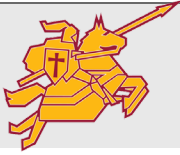

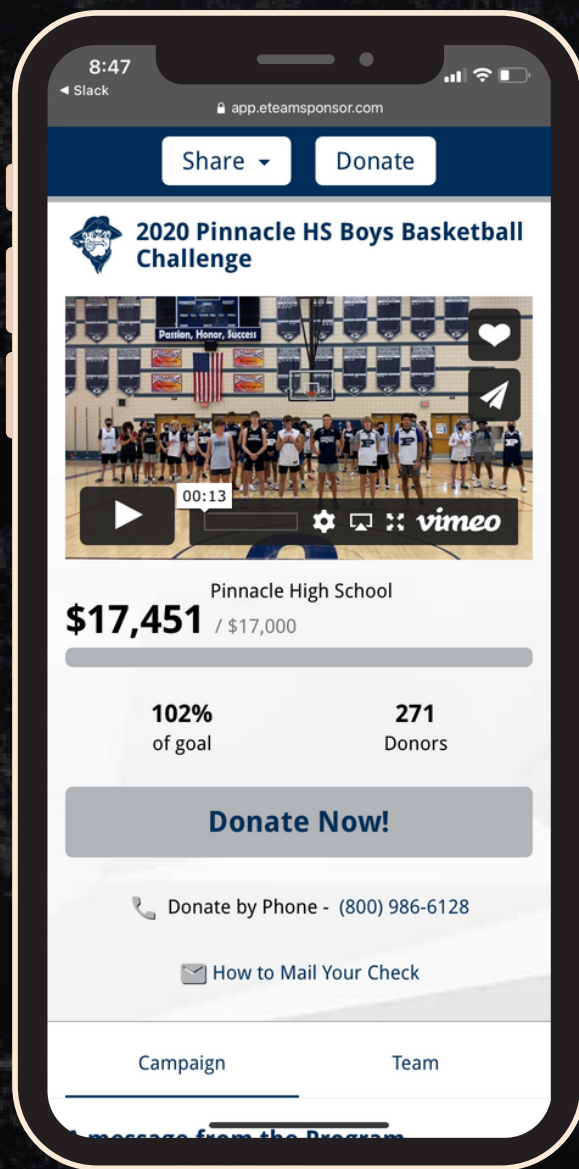

# PAGE LOOKS TO GET THE DREAM RIGHT THIS TIME...UNBEATEN VALLEY CHRISTIAN, ONE-LOSS SNOWFLAKE AWAIT

Although Page High School head girls basketball coach Ryan Whitehorse has not lost this season, he still remembers his team's seven-point loss to Sabino in the 3A title game last season like it was yesterday.

"We still have that bad taste, so we've been using that to motivate ourselves this season," said Whitehorse, whose Sand Devils, besides a 1-0 forfeit over Fountain Hills High School, beat every one of their 14 opponents by 19 points or better this winter. "We want to get back to the finals again and win it all."

Seniors Torrance Begay and Neve Redhair combine to average nearly 20 points and 10 rebounds per contest, courtesy of the notorious game-long press Page has consistently capitalized on even in a 40-21 blowout of No. 2 seed Snowflake, its closest game.

The Lobos that night, however, were playing, for the most part, without star forward Emily Davis. When healthy enough to get a post-entry pass--as she is entering the postseason--the junior Davis is every bit Begay's equal in the post.

"I anticipate to have a rematch with Snowflake in the finals because they're a great defensive team, just like us," Whitehorse said. "They've gotten better as a program in recent years fundamentally, and of course their athleticism and physicality.

"We're looking forward to playing them again and it'll be a very competitive game."

Hopefully, Whitehorse doesn't look past No. 5 seed Valley Christian, which matched the boys' 16-0 unbeaten record this season behind seven seniors, including six-foot, one-inch post Kendahl Moodie, who averages nearly seven rebounds per night.

But even Holbrook head coach Greg Perkins agrees that Page is the clear team to beat.

"They have several seniors who have played in the state championship each of the past three seasons and a great coach," he said. "Page is still the class of the North and of the state in 3A. Someone will have to play a great game to beat them."

Below, how they all match up in the first round then, potentially, for the next two weeks, including overall and region records:

## 1. No. 1 Page (14-0, 8-0) vs. No. 16 Wickenburg (11-6, 5-3)

The road trip to Page is long and draining enough for any team, much less the last team into the girls basketball postseason that has never faced Rez ball this season. That is the road in front of the Wranglers, however, West Region runners-up, coming off a 12-point loss at Anthem Prep.

Power forward Mercy Uldrickson had 20 points to go with 7 rebounds the game before to lead Wickenburg to a 58-40 thumping of No. 7 seed Fountain Hills that punched the Wranglers' ticket. Fellow junior Clare Peterson added 14 points and 7 assists, while freshman Katie Chavarria and senior Pasyn Leavitt each had eight boards of their own. They will need to match, if not exceed, those totals against Page, whose relentless press has made that impossible for most 3A teams. Junior Miquedah Taliman averages over three steals and 13 points per game as a five-foot, 10-inch guard--at a level where most teams are happy to have that height in their center. Also capitalizing off the Page press are sophomore Keira Jenkins, junior Chamique Nez and senior Emma Yazzie.

## No. 2 Snowflake (15-1, 10-0) vs. No. 15 Sabino (6-6, 4-0)

The last team to beat Page has to travel to Snowflake to face the team that gave the Sand Devils the toughest test this season. And that was with forward Emily Davis on the bench, nursing a sprained ankle. Although Kamri Ballard and Macee LeSueur have contributed key outside shooting for the Lobos at points this season, the scores tell the story: Davis is the straw that stirs the drink in head coach Joe Clare's offense. "She's awesome," he

said after Davis had 23 points to fuel a 24-point win at No. 6 seed Winslow. "What more can I say about her?"

Sabino might suggest a defense that would work. There is only so much that Kadie Healy and Emma Wall can do. The two juniors combined for 42 points and 17 rebounds in a loss to Rincon/University High School that started a two-game skid for the Sabercats, who don't want to end their championship defense by backing out of the postseason.

## No. 3 Holbrook (12-4, 8-2) vs. No. 14 Blue Ridge (5-11, 2-8)

Roadrunners head coach Greg Perkins feels lucky to have a veteran team, which has persisted through a schedule shortened and disrupted by Coronavirus stoppages. "So we know what to expect and how hard it is to advance in the bracket," he said. "Basketball seems secondary this year. COVID implications may be the biggest threat for those schools who have to, or I should say choose to deal with it. Not all played on the same level playing field." Runners-up in the East Region, the Roadrunners got a huge boost to their seeding by handing 4A power Flagstaff its only loss in their third game of the season. "We came into that game having dropped the first two of the season, and that game reminded us what we were capable of," Perkins said. "It kind of gave us some of our confidence back at the time." Junior Talynn Spencer scored 13 points in the 54-41 win over the Eagles, and senior Matehya Aberle added 12 to go with her 11 rebounds to pace Holbrook.

Although it finished fifth in the East Region, Blue Ridge made it into the postseason on the strength of wins over Willcox, Safford, Northland Prep and two victories over Payson. The Yellow Jackets are led by five seniors, including Olana Lee, Jaelynn Begay, Valida Carroll, Addasyn Brimhall and Raine Tate.

## No. 4 Thatcher (14-3, 10-0) vs. No. 13 Florence (10-6, 7-3)

This first-round matchup is a rematch of a 20-point blowout Thatcher administered to the Gophers at home Feb. 23. In that contest, three seniors finished in double figures in the scoring column, two Eagles finished with eight rebounds each and the team totaled seven steals. Cassidy Wakefield enjoyed the best of both worlds with 10 points and 8 rebounds, while sophomore Ashlyn Thompson had eight boards of her own. Senior guards Mia Carter and Marleigh Nicolas added 12 points each for the Eagles. Although senior Angelica Gortariz countered with 12 points of her own, there was not the production nor the rebounding around her to keep pace on the road.

## No. 5 Valley Christian (16-0, 10-0) vs. No. 12 Safford (9-8, 7-3)

Although just four players played every game for Trojans head coach Kevin Allen this winter, two of them led Valley Christian in scoring. In fact, sophomore forward Michaela Barbanente has been rock-steady on rebounds as she has on points, averaging 11.5 of each a game to go with nearly four steals. That point total is second to team leader and senior forward Josie Bagley, who at just five feet, four inches tall has still managed to score over 14.5 points a night while posting 5.5 steals.

Runners-up in the South Central, Safford sports a six-point win at Sabino and two double-digit blowouts of Coolidge on its tournament resume. But, especially after losing their only double-figures scorers last season to graduation, when the Bulldogs go cold, games can turn ugly fast. Five of the Bulldogs' eight losses were from 19- up to 32-point margins this season. Sophomore guard Brianna Camarena is the leading returning scorer for Safford, averaging less than six points per game.



**No. 6 Winslow (11-5, 6-4) vs. No. 11 Bourgade Catholic (12-4, 6-2)**

Playing a four-in, one-out offense for head coach Jerron Jordan, the sixth-seeded, undersized Bulldogs have to be crafty around the basket to get their points. Junior guard Kylie Begay, who averages over 12 points on nearly six rebounds per game, is the best at this. Senior Sierra Singer is usually Winslow's only post on the floor, and she has made the most of it, scoring an average of 7.5 points and nearly five boards a night. Junior Jayleigh Meyers helps Singer out in the rebounding department, but the rest of Winslow's points are converted by senior guards Kristin Wagner and Oniah Barton-Paddock off steals and the fast break.

The Metro West Region runners-up Bourgade Catholic forces its opponents into mistakes as well, but in a more deliberate way. The Golden Eagles look for the good shot and otherwise converts turnovers and rebounds. That is why its three seniors--Vivian Hull, Louisa Ibanez and Natalia Ramirez--didn't take that many shots last season. Hull led the team in steals, while junior Emma Henke was the team's leading rebounder.

**No. 7 Show Low (10-9, 4-6) vs. No. 10 Globe (10-3, 7-1)**

This rematch of the Tigers' third game of the season head coach Emily Belvado hopes her team can make a little closer. Losing by 30 on your home court is not an experience any basketball team cares to remember, particularly in the postseason. To close the gap, the smaller Metro East Region runners-up will look to their six seniors, particularly five-foot, ten-inch forward Allison Hudgings. Working the ball inside to her will be Natasha George and Jessie Swift, who also are the team scoring leaders. They each average over 10 points and 4 rebounds a game.

Show Low head coach Michael Brogan has a chance to break out from the shadow of Snowflake and make its own path through the 3A tournament. That could happen if senior guard Laura Ellsworth continues her hot shooting from the perimeter like she did in a 44-35 loss to the Lobos on Feb. 11. If not, Brogan will need to rely on his daughter, Kyra, a five-foot, nine-inch junior, to find opportunities on the interior.

**No. 8 Yuma Catholic (12-1, 9-1) vs. No. 9 Gilbert Christian (16-4, 7-1)**

Unusually for an 8-9 seed matchup, both the Shamrocks of Yuma Catholic and new head coach Albert Wilson's Gilbert Christian Knights are region champions. "Which is a significant accomplishment," said Wilson, whose team finished the regular season atop the Metro West Region. "Being new to Gilbert Christian, our coaching staff's expectation was for our young ladies to glorify God by their efforts and give their very best." Which they did for all but one game, an eight-point loss to runner-up Globe. They also kept it that close with sixth-seeded Winslow and top seed Valley Christian. But Wilson points to the team's closest win, its fifth game of the year at Florence, as one indicative of the Knight's execution and mental toughness. It also started a six-game win streak. "Florence is a well coached team with a style of play that requires physical and mental toughness," Wilson said. "We obviously were pleased with the win, but our execution and mental toughness is what stood out to me." Wilson spreads out minutes among his nine-player rotation, but the leaders are sophomore Lilli Juve, junior Sierra Nielsen and senior post Katelynn Gross. She and her backup, junior Cameryn Jones, combine to average over 10 rebounds a game.

They will need them against the dangerous Shamrocks, whose only loss this season was by 12 points at No. 16 seed Wickenburg. "We had a stretch at home where we played great basketball, with our defense creating turnovers which led to easy transition baskets," head coach Bobby McGalliard said. "Our schedule was tough in terms of travel, but we are appreciative of the fact we got to play. I know it's not an original saying, but our motto is 'Control the controllables,' and we can't control where the AIA decides to play the games." What they can control is offensive execution, and Yuma Catholic can win as long as it isn't relying on senior Kylie Meerchaum to score on her own like she did at Wickenburg, where she had 17 but no other player scored more than eight points. McGalliard needs senior Rori Martinez and sophomore Reese Sellers to score to their double-figure averages, and he needs senior Isabel Torok and sophomores Hannah Swarthout and Rian Martinez to create more opportunities for these players.

# ROAD LITTERED WITH TALENT IN 2A STATE BRACKET

Lord of the Rings has a good ring to it for a coach with a championship pedigree.

But Arizona Lutheran Academy basketball coach Benjy Wells, a fan of the Lord of the Rings volumes, isn't looking ahead. The English teacher may be new to the Arizona girls basketball scene, but Wells is keenly aware that the journey to a 2A Conference title this year will be bumpy.

Wells' undefeated Coyotes, the No. 2 seed, isn't the only team in the hunt to raise the 2A trophy at the end. Last year's 2A titlist, Thatcher, is now competing for the 3A crown as the 4th seed.

But before earning its 3A berth, Thatcher had to sweat out a two-point victory over another 2A favorite, Pima, in their final regular season game. Its lone loss of the year, however, didn't keep Pima, a quarterfinalist last year, from being awarded the top seed in this year's 2A tourney.

Undefeated Sedona Red Rock and Round Valley as well as the rest of the competitive field also figure to have a say in who ultimately winds up as 2A champ. The last time Arizona Lutheran cut the nets was 30 years ago.

Wells is a Nebraska native, where he coached for 11 years, who was ready for a change. Through his contacts at an Arizona Lutheran sister school, the coach was informed about the opening at the Phoenix school, where he made a good first impression.

He guided his team to a 17-0 mark and 2A West Region title with only two seniors on the team. But those two upperclassmen, Olivia Meyer and Paige Martin, aren't too shabby.

They are the captains of an unselfish team with depth.

"They both lead by example and vocally," Wells said.

"They are high character kids who represent who we want to be as a team and program on and off the court."

Meyer and Martin are also best friends as well as students of the game. Paige, a guard, has a good sense of when to shoot or penetrate, Wells said.

Meyer understands the game as well as any kid Wells has coached. That's not surprising since the 5-9 forward is the daughter of Arizona Lutheran's well-respected boy's coach Doug Meyer.

But the Coyotes have more than just two weapons. The team's starters have each scored in double figures at some point this season.

Starters Rachel Stahmann, a 6-1 junior forward, and Elise Bayer, a 5-11 junior forward, are each contributing seven boards or more per game as well as sophomore bench player Eleana Massadeh. Having depth has allowed the Coyotes to play more in transition this year and keep up with the demands of Wells' man-to-man defense.

"It does start on the defensive end," he said. "It's a big focus, and every last person has bought in to playing good defense, great defense at times. The team concept and being connected and being in the right spot and committed to that, they've taken a lot of pride in that."

Arizona Lutheran's opponents are averaging only about 22 points per game.

The first postseason test for the Coyotes arrives on March 10 against a team it hasn't seen this season, 15thseed Glendale Prep, in a first round home game. But Arizona Lutheran is prepared for the first potential road-block.

"The character and leadership of this group is very strong," Wells said. "Our seniors set a great example for what they do and how they represent our program, their families, and ultimately their Lord both on and off the floor. Our juniors and sophomores show great leadership qualities and hold themselves to high standards as well, and we've been really united in displaying those qualities this season as individuals and collectively."

**Sedona Red Rock:** The Scorpions couldn't win the big games last year, but that's not the case for 12-0 Red Rock this season. Defense and balanced scoring are what you get with the Sedona program with only one senior, Lesly Suarez. "We are sort of quiet up here in Sedona," coach Kirk Westervelt said. "I'm a blue collar, lunch pail coach. If you can't share you aren't going to play for us." Two years ago, the team was losing some games by 40 points. But things started to change when Westervelt took over last year. He took a page out of Hall of Famer Nolan Richardson's 40 minutes of hell game plan at Arkansas when it comes to playing defense. "I loved watching Nolan. He was unselfish and always played trapping defense. We've got two hours of practice every day, but it's running and trapping every day." Westervelt's roster is also filled with 4.0 students, including his daughter Helen, a sophomore guard who's been starting since last year. ... **Pima:** The Roughriders are also young and getting contributions from a lot of players. Sophomore Ashlynn Chlarson averages 9.3 rebounds per game and is one of four players with double figures in points every night. Junior Saydee Allred is the scoring leader with 13.6 per game. Pima played in probably the toughest 2A Region, the East, this season. ... **Round Valley** finished second in the 2A East. The team returned four seniors and a new coach, Cheryl Tysseling. ... **St. Johns** is 11-6 but lost a couple of its games to 3A teams. It wound up with the 4th seed in the 2A tournament. ... Emily Darwin is averaging 17 points and 8.9 rebounds per game for 13-1 **Benson**.
