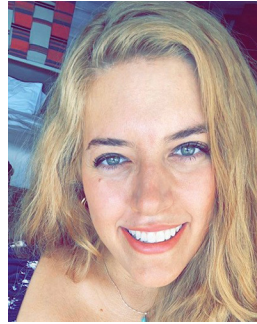


Jennifer McKusick
