HOWRY HAS MADE NW CHRISTIAN INTO MAJOR LEAGUE PLAYER OF THE 3A FIELD

Former Major League pitcher Bob Howry is poised for his most successful season in five years as head coach at top 3A seed Northwest Christian, the only undefeated team in the conference's postseason field.

But Pusch Ridge Christian Academy, American Leadership Academy - Gilbert North and Yuma Catholic high schools will have something to say about that after the 3A state tournament play-in winners are decided Saturday, April 30.

No doubt riding an 18-0 run to a state championship would rival any of the accomplishments of a 13-year MLB career that began and ended in Chicago, where Howry made millions hurling more than 65 saves and 650 strikeouts with a sub-4.00 earned-run average for the White Sox, and Cubs, among the Diamondbacks and three other Major League Baseball teams.

He inherited a Crusaders program coming off three state championship appearances and two titles under two different head coaches in its previous four seasons. After he and son Ty, a pitcher at Wichita State University, made a surprise state semifinal run as a ninth seed in 2019, Howry's team, now fully his own, has returned to prominence in his fourth full season.

A slow start this spring, losing two of three at the Laveen Baseball Classic tournament to top out-of-conference contenders Estrella Foothills and Alhambra, was followed by results that speak for themselves: 21-1 overall and undefeated against all Arizona opponents, including a 10-0 run through the North Central Region. Seven of those games were blowouts by 10 or more runs in five- and six-inning affairs that triggered the Arizona Interscholastic Association mercy rule.

As much muscle as was flexed by Howry's bats in that run, in which the Crusaders assaulted regional pitching by a total of 128-18, his experience on the mound has paid the most dividends, especially with two of just three seniors on his squad: staff ace Andrew Richardson and Dale Fry.

Keeping such key arms rested at a count of 100 pitches or less per game has been just as integral to the resurgence of the Crusaders as sophomore starters like Gunnar Penzkover and Trot Simms, who shut out Bourgade Catholic with just 69 pitches April 20.

Penzkover, with his bat as well as with his arm, showed that the Crusaders are tournament-tested. His two-RBI single March 23 against second seed ALA - Gilbert North turned a 3-2 extra-inning deficit into a 4-3 walk-off win.

The eight-inning clutch comeback, in which Penzkover also got the win on the mound in relief of Fry, came just eight days after a similar closeout of No. 3 Yuma Catholic. His 26 pitches mopping up March 15 for Fry helped the Crusaders out-duel the Shamrocks and freshman Mickey Fox, one of just five 3A pitchers who have thrown no-hitters this season, in Fox's case to one of the conference's top defensive catchers in senior Alan Cuen.

Caveat observator: The 10-7 road win came without having to face, on the mound, Yuma Catholic senior Issac Araiza—a nine-game winner and one of just two Arizona pitchers to strike out more than 100 batters this spring.

Araiza's .653 on-base percentage, second in 3A, has helped push across teammates like junior infielder Juan Lugo, one of the conference's top run scorers with 36.

The state's strikeout king? Pusch Ridge Christian Academy senior Alessandro Castro, Top 20 nationally in Ks with 107 and a sub-1.00 earned-run average.

With a .538 batting average, he is no slouch at the plate either. Castro's 38 runs scored actually rank second on the team to short-stop Jacob "Bubba" Mustain, tied for fifth in the conference with 30.

The Lions' greatest offensive threat, however, is senior outfielder Logan Brown, one of the conference's top sluggers with 42 RBIs, including six home runs.

Castro's little brother Andres, a sophomore five-game winner who also has a no-hitter to his credit—and whose only loss came in the bottom of the seventh to the second-seeded Eagles in his season-opening tournament—also has batted in 32 runs.

Throwing to reliable senior Isaac Rolon behind the plate, their arms have kept Pusch Ridge as a fifth seed just behind 14-4 Valley Christian, responsible for the Eagles' only other two losses after a doubleheader sweep at home April 22.

While the fourth-seeded Trojans needed nine innings to edge the Eagles in the first game, the second game head coach Brett Brewer is hoping was an anomalous outlier, as two of his five-game winners, Dawson Morris and Spencer Nielson, were pummeled for eight runs in the first five innings of a 13-1 run-ruling in six.

Valley Christian juniors Hunter Heeringa and Ryan Kao combined for eight of the nine earned runs, picking up the slack for freshman Caleb Danzeisen, who is one of the conference leaders with 35 RBIs and six home runs.

Brewer should have sophomore seven-game winner Hayden Clegg ready to go Tuesday, May 3, with Morris, who still sports a sparkling 1.17 ERA, recovered for a deeper run.

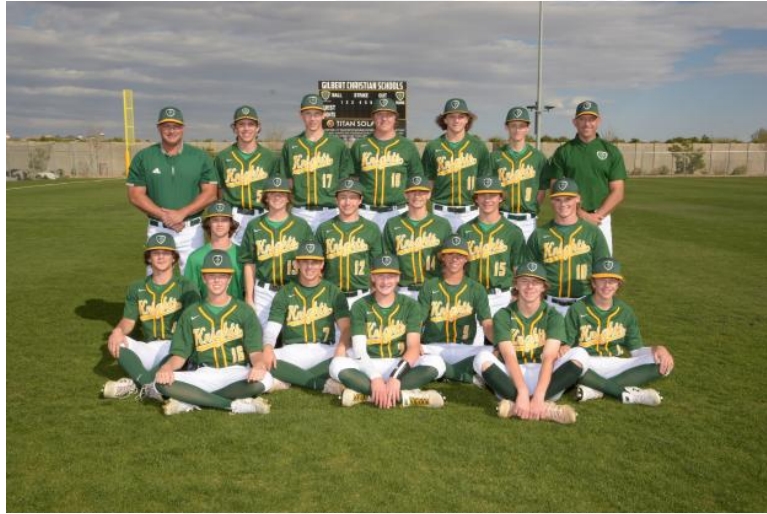

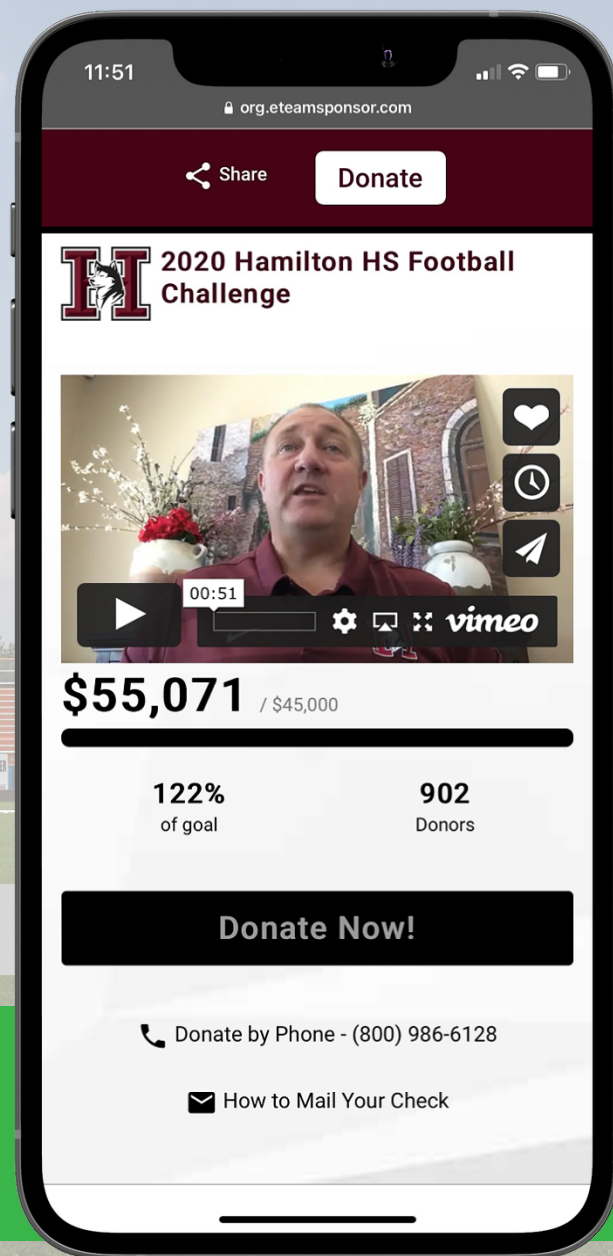

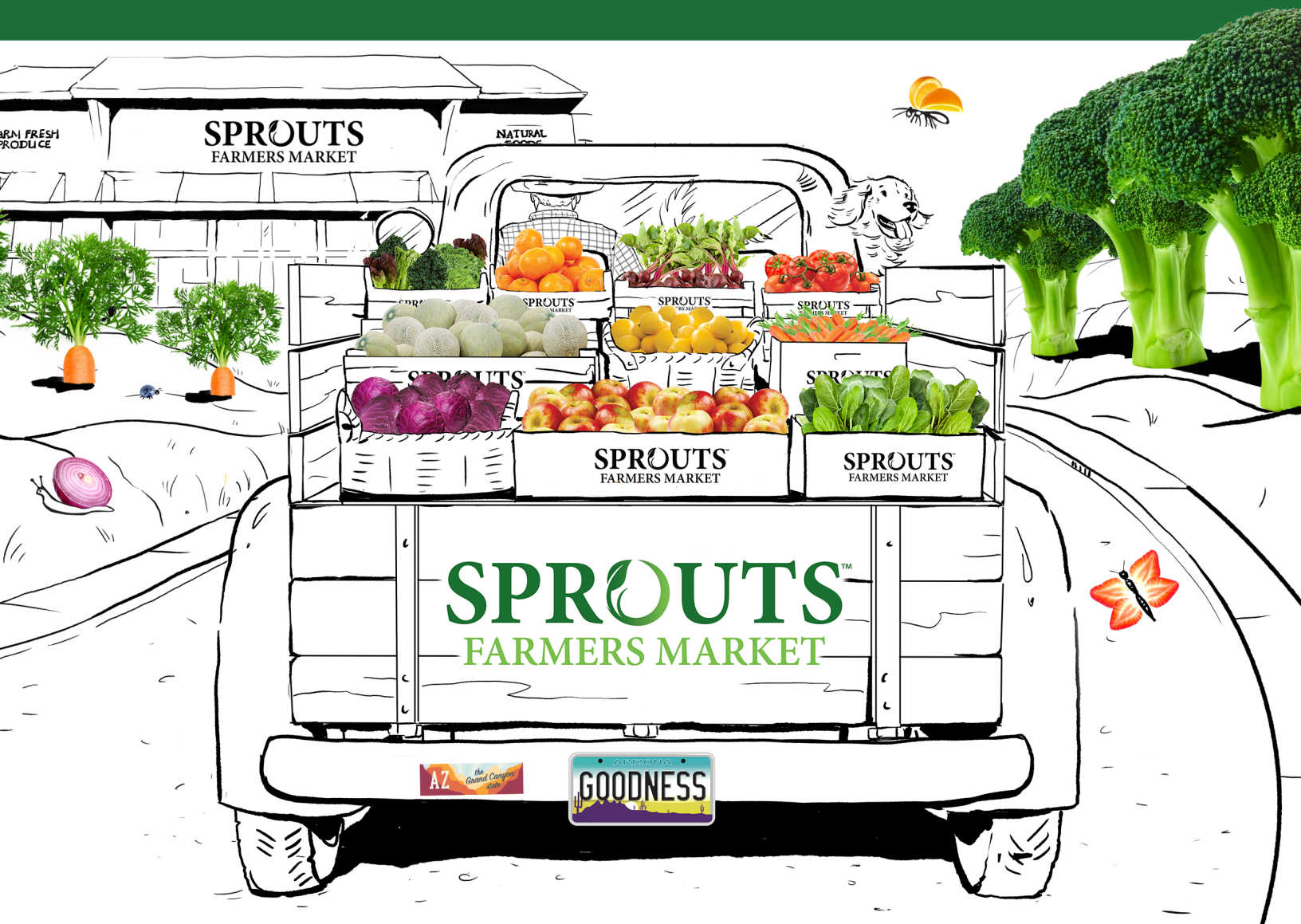

SCOTTSDALE CHRISTIAN AFTER ANOTHER 2A TITLE FOLLOWING 2021'S SETBACK

News and notes for the top teams in the 2A Conference tournament.

MIAMI: "I feel that we have gotten to where we are at this point due to our bats and team speed," coach Brandon Powell said. "I do feel we are right in the mix of teams that can make a run. Scottsdale Christian is a bit ahead of the rest of the field, but after them I think there are about 10-12 teams that are fairly evenly matched. If our bats stay hot, we should be right in the mix. I have three arms that are slightly above average 2A arms." Miami won its sixth region title in a row and was close to breaking the state record for most runs scored in a season. Miami was batting .499, with six players hitting above .500. Junior Aden Guthrey (.683 ave.) and senior Gabe Escobedo (.571 ave., 47 RBI's) are the batting leaders. Escobedo is also 9-1 with a 1.80 ERA.

TOMBSTONE: "I think the biggest factors for our success this year has been our pitching depth and a solid defense," coach Jamie Milligan said. "While I don't necessarily have one guy that can shut anyone down completely, I have five or six quality pitchers that throw strikes and have a good secondary pitch. This, coupled with our defense that averages about two errors a game, has kept us in most games that we have played." Tombstone's leader is senior C/SS Joel Esparza. "Joel is not a vocal leader, but a leader by example," Milligan said. "He sets the bar for our team in terms of self-confidence, effort, hustle, and attitude." The team had some question marks this season after losing several starters from the 2020-21 team. But junior P/INF Cesar Cañez and sophomore INF/RHP Gabe Garcia helped fill the void. Freshman DJ Elias also stepped in and is leading the team in wins while also producing at the plate. "I think it will be a great tournament with several teams that could potentially win it," Milligan said. "The 2A East will likely have all six teams represented in the top-16 and most section games have been hotly contested, and all should be ready for the playoffs. I see Scottsdale Christian and returning champion Benson as the favorites. Miami is right there, too. After those three, there are probably 3-4 other teams that have a shot if they can get on a roll."

MORENCI: Sophomore UTIL/C Anthony Ballesteros (.369 ave.) and sophomore Austyn Nelson are two of the youngsters that stepped into new roles and flourished. Junior UTIL/P/SS Daylen Johnson (.500 ave., 6-2 on the mound), Shawn Hudman and senior Tony Roybal (.485 ave., 3.22 ERA) lead by example, coach Christopher Aguallo said. "All three are able to get the team on the same page," he said. "Shawn was just accepted to West Point and has leading in his blood. The unsung hero for our group is Emilio Roybal (.340 ave.). He's a sophomore playing second base and doing a great job this year in the field and with the bat."

HORIZON HONORS: "The biggest factor for our success has been how well our underclassmen have stepped up to take leadership roles," coach Tom Kandler said. "We do not have a senior on the team and typically start three juniors, four sophomores and three freshmen. We do not name captains as we feel captains emerge and are not named. It really has been a group effort and players have defined their own roles and that includes leadership." After last season, Horizon Honors lost six starters, including most of its pitching staff. But sophomore Antonio Arellano (7-1), junior Nate Neis and junior Ben Hamby and others joined sophomore Austin Ragsdale (7-0, 1.54 ERA, 81 strikeouts in 45.1 innings) to form a formidable pitching staff, Kandler said.

RIVER VALLEY: "We fashion a routine to help create a structure we can use as a team," coach William Fregozo said. "And with a routine and structure we build discipline, which follows them in their future as they move on to college or into a working career. That mentality helps build a strong team atmosphere." The leaders of the team are sophomore 3B/1B CJ Hunter (.421 ave.) and senior football star Zach Hammett. "The team really looks up to (Hunter and Hammett)," Fregozo said. "They don't show fear, and they take things in stride." The team's unsung hero this season is junior C/1B Thomas Farnham. "He has been behind the plate every game of the

season, including tournament play. He has not missed a single inning. The catcher never gets credit for the strikes the pitcher throws, and the catcher always gets beat up with the wild pitches he can't get to." River Valley only has three seniors. It also carries three juniors, five sophomore and one freshman. "As a team, these boys can play well and will be a good team while getting ready for next season."

ROUND VALLEY: The Elks went from four wins to 17 this season. "The kids have bought in and play as a team not as individuals," coach Troy Merrill said. "They are putting more quality time and work in. They give me all they have and then some." The team's leaders are a sophomore OF/F Ryker Marble, senior SS/P Padilla and junior 1B/OF/P Treyson Merrill. "Ryker is batting over .500 hundred and is maybe one of the best baseball players I have seen in recent years," Troy said. "Trey (Merrill) brings great work ethic, is batting .419 and is leading our team in RBI's and is a great kid. Trey (Padilla) is batting .430 on the year and has great speed and talent." Troy said everybody on his team has contributed to this year's success. "I think the 2A has a lot of talented teams, but we have a chance to make a run for at championship," coach said.

SCOTTSDALE PREP: "We have done an excellent job swinging the bat," said coach David Primavera about his team, which was batting over .360. "We are able to put pressure on the defense, which leads to opponents' mistakes." INF/P Brandon Ohre (.543 ave., 36 RBI's) is one of the senior leaders on the team. "He works hard every day at practice," Primavera said. "He brings an energy to the team that is contagious." Junior C Bohrer was 7-1 with a 1.22 ERA and 63 strikeouts in 40 innings. Senior leadoff hitter Devon Strader has stolen 11 bases. "Devon does a great job getting on base and stealing extra bases," coach said. "He is also an excellent outfielder who covers a lot of ground."

Notes: Since maxpreps.com started keeping track of high school stats in 2004, **Scottsdale Christian** has only had one losing season. This season, the 19-4 Eagles haven't lost to a 2A team. Coach Tim Salmon is 130-53-4 during his eight seasons with the team. His pitching staff has allowed the fewest runs in 2A this season. His staff's ERA is 3.07. Mason Schmidt was 7-1 with a 2.88 ERA and was averaging close to two strikeouts per inning. Junior Kadon Quitno was hitting .500 with six home runs. Corwin Hemmingsen had 40 RBI's after 56 at bats. ... Fred Trujillo's **Benson** program has won at least 17 games during each of his three full seasons as head coach. Last year, he guided Benson to its first 2A title in 34 years. Senior Wyatt Wilharm has a .531 career batting average. He hit .440 last year but is batting .628 this season, the third highest average in 2A this season. His 46 RBI's also ranks in the top-3 in 2A this season and is also 5-0 on the mound. Tristan Martinez is 5-1.

AS ALWAYS, THE 1A TROPHY IS ANYONE'S FOR THE TAKING

News and notes for the top teams in the 1A Conference tournament.

MOGOLLON: The team has a dedicated group of players who played on its state championship team in 2019. "It's highly competitive group of players that work together and for each other," coach Reed Porter said. "We have great leadership from seniors Malaki Porter, Cael Porter, Fisher Porter, and Braxton Owens," Reed said. "That group has won two football state championships, seven individual wrestling state championships and one baseball state championship. They know what it takes to win, and they are willing to put in the time to be highly successful," Reed said. The weight room became a second home for those players. The leaders, especially Malaki, organize 6 a.m. batting practices three times a week. The unsung heroes of the team have been outfielder Payton Reidhead ('Consistency in the field and batting'), catcher Adrian Suarez ('Not a catcher by desire, but willing to take on that role to put the best team on the field') and second baseman Kyson Owens ('Huge improvements over the past year.')."

BAGDAD: The team returned seven starters from last year's team. It has two quality pitchers in Connor Watson and Shane Hooper. They also hold a solid third option, Deegan Owings. Watson's fastball can reach the mid to upper 80s and also possesses a good slider and quality change up, coach Dalton Mills said. "What's good about Connor is that he is athletic and has pitched in some big games in the past, a state championship as a freshman and a semifinal last year," Mills said. Watson's quick bat is helping him hit over .530. Hooper, just a sophomore, has big game experience as well and picked up wins over 3A Wickenburg, 4A Lee Williams and 1A's No. 1 seed Mogollon. "He spots his fastball well and has a good curve ball to go with it," Mills said. "Cooper Williams is our senior leader. The one great thing about Coop is he leads on and off the field. He is one of the top students in the senior class, he has a positive outlook and is not afraid to say and do the right thing. His parents have done a tremendous job with him and his sister. His sister Briah is a leader on our softball team." Williams is leading Bagdad in hits, home runs, RBI's, runs, walks and is the new season state record holder in stolen bases.

WILLIAMS: "I think the biggest factor for our success this season is our lightened approach to the game," coach Ethan Johnson said. "We have really tried to embrace the 'play the game mentality.' We try not to dwell on anything previous or to over excite over the next opponent. We are just trying to keep a simple approach and try to have a bunch of small victories." Williams' standouts are sophomore Tyler Jensen and junior Danny Siegfried. "Tyler is our catcher and leadoff hitter," Johnson said. "He comes with tons of baseball IQ and is a true competitor. He is vocal leader and his desire to win is second to none. Danny is a junior pitcher/utility and is often a key to our success on the offensive side. He is a great teammate and loves the game of baseball." The unsung heroes of this year's team, Johnson said, have been his senior class, including starters Joseph Siegfried, Preston Ford, Oryn Orozco and Jacob Giles. "These boys don't always stand out in the box scores, but their consistency and timely play have also played a huge role in our success," Johnson said.

ST. DAVID: The defending champ holds one of the top pitchers in 1A in Ryan Gooding. According to maxpreps, this is Gooding's first season on varsity. The junior was 10-2 with a 1.48 ERA and 76 strikeouts in 61.2 innings. The only 1A loss St. David suffered was to Hayden. Its other losses came to 2A's Benson and Tombstone and 3A's Safford.

ANTHEM PREP: The secret to the team's success is simple: Throwing strikes and hitting at a high level. The team's batting average was .450 and had struck out 134 after 90 innings. Sophomore Nic DeSilva and junior Ronan Whitley are the ring leaders of Anthem Prep's pitching staff. Six players were hitting .455 or better, led by senior Ethan Kuchta's .605 average. But the leaders of the team are seniors Aidan Quirk and Brennan Navarro-Bania. "Aidan is always teaching the game to others," coach Richard Watmore said. "Brennan is cheering his teammates on with positivity." The unsung heroes of this year's team have been freshman 2B/RF Jaxon MacHugh and senior CF/SS Taylor Beeman, Watmore said.

JOSEPH CITY: Junior shortstop Bannon Johnstun had only two errors and was hitting over .500 for Joseph City. "In the games that we have won we have had stellar pitching and very few errors," coach Shawn Layden said. "Our hitting in the games we have won has also been extremely good." Senior 3B/P Karter Lampsa (2.36 ERA after 10 appearances) is the ace of the staff, but the pitching staff is deep with juniors and a freshman who have also stepped up. "All my seniors are unsung heroes, because many of them don't start but contribute as pinch runners, pinch hitters, and are positive bench players," Layden said.

HAYDEN: "I believe the biggest success factors for this team are cohesiveness, unity, respect, and support we have for each other," veteran coach Robert Lorona said. "The positive way that this Lobo team responds to adversity and overcome obstacles is amazing." Sophomore Deondre Collier (.500 ave.), Rene Arbizo (.404 ave.), Brandon Garner (.417 ave.), and Moraes Cruz (.439 ave, 25 RBIs) are the team's hitting leaders. "Our upper classmen's leadership has been a big quality this year, and I credit them for being the unsung heroes for this season," Lorona added.

NOTES: Dylan Mitchell and Jace Mitchell were each hitting over .460 for **Valley Union**. ... **Fredonia** won seven of its final eight regular season games. ... Johnavon Pace had 35 RBI's for **Ray**. ... **Lincoln Prep** reached the playoffs in its second season of existence. ... The workhorse on the mound for **Desert Christian** is Bennett Vondrak (46 innings, 79 K's, 4-1 record). ... Wyatt Eyler was hitting .722 after 13 games for **Mayer**. ... The pandemic got in the way, but **Baboquivari** is back in the playoffs for the first time since 2019. ... **Tempe Prep's** Cole Rotner has struck out 84 batters in 46 innings. ... Freshman Matt Brennan was leading **Mohave Accelerated** with a .381 average.

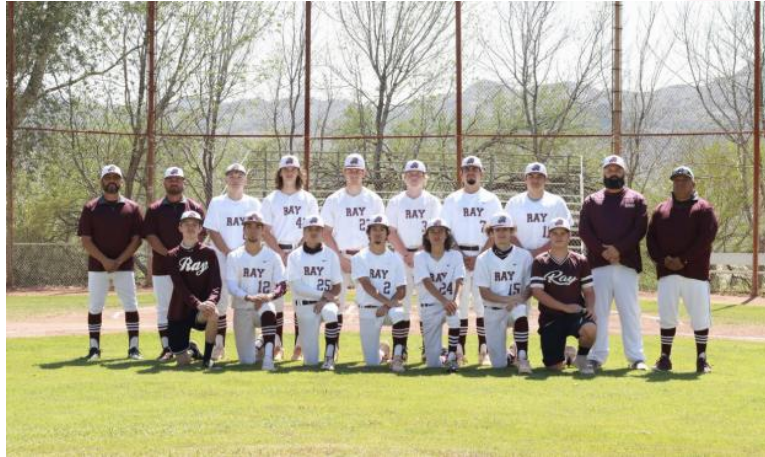
