

SABINO'S QUEST TO THREE-PEAT FACES CHALLENGES NORTH BY NORTHWEST

Sabino High School has ruled 3A softball for so long, its seniors have never lost a postseason game.

They also would be hard-pressed to explain a loss to anyone other than Salpointe, 4A's undefeated leader that handed the Sabercats their only setbacks this season.

Even the coaching staff has changed since their last conference loss, a 3-0 shutout more than four years ago at the last team to win a 3A title before them, Sahuarita.

So there is currently no ceiling to the confidence of head coach Cyndi Cubillas or her 17-1 juggernaut, which begins the hunt for its third straight state championship at home Tuesday, May 3.

There is only the inevitable unknown–an opportunity for revenge that challengers like the last three 3A runners-up, Payson, Snowflake and Winslow, would be more than happy to seize.

While the Longhorns remain a tough out behind their junior triumvirate of infielders Mia Hall, Ivy Woolwine and catcher Hailey Bramlet, the dual losses of head coach Curtis Johnson and 2021 title game pitcher Raci Miranda have left voids even tougher to fill. With six more losses than last season, Payson has dropped from a third seed to 13th this postseason despite Hall's seven home runs, Woolwine's .574 batting average and Bramlet's 10 base runners caught stealing.

So to stop Sabino and end the reign of the two-time defending champs, any opponent will have to get through to 16-game winner Riley Nielson. As the senior sports a 1.57 earned-run average and has struck out 165 batters, easier said than done.

Manage to touch her, and opponents still have little sister Avery, a freshman who no-hit Bourgade and Catalina, back-to-back, to deal with.

All while attempting to mitigate one of the conference's top sluggers and catchers, junior Gianna Pancost. Her 44 runs batted in, including seven home runs, tie Pancost with Winslow junior Brynlee Barris for third in 3A.


While Barris trails Pancost by a homer and has just top-three run scorer Mikell Branson in offensive support for the No. 2 Bulldogs, however, Pancost has played a big part in plating three of the conference's top 10 run scorers, including leader Yesamin Aguilar and junior outfield mates Reese and Riley McFarland.

But there is no shortage of motivation to knock off the Sabercats, starting with Maren Berger in Snowflake. Four years ago, she could only sit in Arizona State University's stands and watch older sister Anna get jumped on by the Sabercats for six runs in the first two innings of their 2019 state championship blowout.

This postseason, 3A has no greater combined threat on the mound and at the plate than the junior for the fourth-seeded Lobos. Berger not only has tied Riley Nielson's win total for second in the conference, she has hurled nearly 100 more strikeouts, and her ERA is more than a half-run better—a flat 1.00.

A top-four slugger in the conference, Berger also is its second-leading home-run hitter with 10, augmenting a .574 batting average with 42 RBIs.

Just one RBI and three homers behind Berger is battery mate Lillieann Hollom. The junior catcher has thrown out 18 of the 28 base runners who have attempted to steal a base on her this spring.

Only pitcher Maddy Blair can rival Berger's dual-threat capabilities. The junior ace for Northwest Christian has matched Barris this spring with six home runs and also has 16 wins on the mound with a 1.93 ERA.

Her catcher, junior Macie Thomas, has ensured that even if runners get on, any runs they score will have to be earned. Thomas has thrown out 17 of 25 opposing base runners this spring. That statistic will be put to the test if the Crusaders advance to play third-seeded Page, which had not lost a conference game this season before a two-run comeback on the final out, 7-6 at 12thranked Chino Valley.

The eighth-inning rally put a slight damper on the ERA of ace Grace Jump, who came into the Freedom game eighth in Arizona in the category at 0.91. Still, the junior 13-game winner is one of the state's top 10 strikeout queens with 209 while sporting a .618 batting average and .655 on-base percentage—fifth and ninth in the conference, respectively.

In the Sand Devils' half of the inning at the plate, for base-stealing and sheer offensive power, there is no more dominant a group of 3A hitters than in Page. Joining Jump among the top five 3A batting averages are junior infielder Calena Miller and sophomore catcher Miakoda Whitehorse, one of the conference's top three sluggers batting .660.

One of 3A's top fielders behind the plate as well, Whitehorse gets on-base the second-most in the conference–nearly 70 percent of the time. Miller is right behind her, however, with a .994 fielding percentage, a .622 batting average and a .649 on-base percentage.

That is where Miller turns into a dual threat, as she is one of three Sand Devils who have combined for 91 stolen bases. Junior infielder Tessa Cummings is second in the conference in the category, with sophomore utility player Kylee Sam contributing 25 thefts of her own.





FIRST TITLE WAS ONLY THE BEGINNING FOR RIVER VALLEY IN 2A

News and notes for some of the top teams in the 2A Conference tournament.

BENSON: "I feel one of the biggest factors to our success this season would be our returners from last season's team," coach Bert Cardenas said. "We were able to gain some valuable experience and continue to build on those experiences." The roster is filled with leaders, but junior INF/P Celina Wilharm certainly stands out. She leads Benson in hitting as well as in the circle. "Celina is one of the most competitive girls I have coached, and she will do anything to win a game," Cardenas said. "We will have to battle with some great teams to reach our goal of a state championship. Round Valley, River Valley and Santa Cruz all have great teams and we look forward to competing against them down the road. There are also teams like Willcox and Morenci who can compete with anyone in the state. However, I still feel that we are one of the favorites in 2A."

ROUND VALLEY: "We have a group of young ladies that have played together since grade school and have worked hard in the offseason to further improve their skill," coach Darin Emerald said. "We will be graduating six seniors this year and each and every one has contributed to building this program and being role models to our up and coming young players. We have leadership, dedication and heart. This team does not give up." Round Valley was leading 2A in home runs with 36. Nine of its players have hit a home run, with sophomore Liliana Arreloa leading the way with 11. "The long ball has definitely been a key part to our success thus far," Emerald said. "We have many leaders on this team and as a coach it is always exciting to see who is going to step up and show those leadership skills. This team is in the hunt for a state title and preparing vigorously to represent our community to the best of our ability."

RIVER VALLEY: "It's been a team effort, every player putting the teams needs before their own," said coach John Glenn about his squad, the defending 2A champ. The team leaders are senior 3B/RF Rusti Glenn (.538 batting ave.), senior SS/CF Talynn Williams (.582 ave.) and junior catcher Karina Pulu (.690 ave., 8 home runs, 36 RBIs). "They lead by example, work ethic and commitment," John said. "They understand that they can't ask a teammate to do anything they won't just do themselves. They lead by example." The unsung heroes of the team are outfielders Liberty Lillard, Shelby Anderson and Kaileigh Sturdivant, John said. A couple of sophomores, Trinity Williams and Aaliyah Rodriguez, stepped in and de-livered during the regular season as well. Williams was 12-2 in the circle with a 3.28 ERA and 93 strikeouts in 81 innings. Rodriguez, a first baseman, was leading the team with a .612 average.

SANTA CRUZ: "The camaraderie and energy of the team has been great," coach Andrew James said. "Obviously, these girls can play ball but their energy is contagious. These girls feed off each other's success. When you have a bunch of girls that get excited for each other, it's fun to watch and great for the team." Different players have stepped up throughout the season for Santa Cruz. "I don't know if we have specific leaders. These girls have been together for a long time and really know each other well. They know how to pick each other up and get each other going. We have a system that they are all familiar with. They show up and get the work done. Defensively, they rally behind the pitchers like any other team. Offensively, any one of them in the lineup can set the tone. They are willing to do what's needed to move a runner or score the run. They are not selfish and do what's needed for the betterment of the team. The team faced No. 1 seed Benson in its second game of the season, dropping a 13-9 decision. "Obviously, they are a great program. We have not seen Round Valley or River Valley, so it's tough to comment. River Valley is always in the race but other than stats, we don't know much about the kids. I think those are the top four." This is the first time that some of the team's players will play a full season. COVID shortened the previous two seasons. "This year has been fun," James said. "I'm glad our girls were able to get a full season under their belt. We really have a good group of girls and a great support system. We try to run a top-notch program with practice and everything that leads up to game time. It's all the little things, the practices, the music, the pregame meals and snacks, and the swag that comes with any team that looks good and feels good. That's been the key. These girls have a great time, and love to see their teammates have success. Don't' get me wrong, they all pay attention to their numbers, but they really do celebrate each other's success. This is a special group of girls.

MORENCI: "I think the biggest factor to our success is that our girls enjoy the process of getting better," coach Joe Garcia said. "They are always energetic and excited about the process because they have learned that that is how they can become successful. Furthermore, the girls have worked hard on their approaches at the plate, which has led to an increase in runs scored." The leaders of the team are junior OF/1B Mia Ontiveros, senior 1B Juliauna Forgach-Aguilar and senior utility Devanie Medina. "Mia has done a great job as an example in the outfield," Garcia said. "She flies around out there, making big play after big play. It is infectious and it brings up the intensity level of the other girls. Juliana has done a solid job at both first base and in the leadoff position in our batting lineup. With her high batting average and tenacity for getting on base in general, she gets our hitters going. Devanie has done a solid job behind the plate as our catcher. She works hard on her blocking abilities and has a strong arm." NORTHLAND PREP: Despite losing five starters off of last year's team, Northland Prep won 18 games for the first time in the program's histo-ry. "This is a very small group, with 12 players, but it's a close group that celebrates each and every success regardless of how large or small. I appreciate that in this group." The leader of the team is senior SS/P Maggie Auza. "She is one of our captains this year and has really become a great leader for the team," Dean said. "She has a great ability to bring people together and reinforce the direction from the coaches to the other players. She keeps her finger on the pulse of the team, which helps the coaching staff provide the support where needed earlier rather than later. Maggie is easy going, can build consensus on the team and leads by example." A lot more folks have contributed to the team's success on and off the field. "All our ladies are our heroes," coach said. "But the freshman class along with our new ladies to softball have all stepped up to help us accomplish our goals this season. We have an amazing group of parents that step up to help with assistant coaching, score keeping, field prep and cleanup, meals for travel, fundraising, etc. We could not be as successful without their participation and support. So my heartfelt thanks to all of them for their support."



Miners aim to be major players in **1A**

News and notes for some of the top teams in the 1A Conference tournament.

San Manuel: It's didn't take long for San Manuel, the 2021 runner-up, to start thinking about improving. "As soon as the (2021) game finished in the championship," coach Angela Sierra said, "we wanted to get back on the field and start preparing for the next year." This season, Sierra said that keeping her team's energy up, executing bunts and putting the ball in play are big reasons for her team's success. "(P/1B) Jazmyne (Waddell) and 1A/3B Aubrey (Encinas) are huge assets to this team," coach said. "They lead and motivate these girls to work hard and get the job done. (Freshman outfielder) Marina Madrid always gives a 110% every day. She is always wanting to improve. She is cheering and being the best she can when she is playing and even when she isn't." Encinas is batting .595, and Waddell is hitting .689.

Superior: Great pitching performances from Danika Bryant combined with excellent hitting by Bryant, Julianna Navarro, Myika Cruz and Alianna Lopez have helped keep Superior softball stay ahead of the pack, according to coach Alfonso Lopez. "All four seniors are contributing, each with their own style of leadership skills," Lopez said. "They have contributed tremendously in helping the younger girls grow in the sport and become very good assets to the team." One of the unsung heroes of the team is Julianna Navarro. "She has always been a great hitter, but this year she's come out with power, too," Lopez said. "She currently has nine home runs." Lopez added that it's been a challenging school year for his program. "The last two years we've seen a lack of playing experience due to COVID, so we are spending a lot of time trying to bring these younger girls up to the varsity level quickly," he said. "In a small town environment, there are not very many participants, so it can be challenging at times. But we are really proud of our seniors as they have done their part, and then some, to help out for the good of the team."

Williams: "The girls are having a good time and working on the improvements needed to reach their goal to win the last game," coach Raul Hatch said. Sophomore Kai Mortensen was batting about .560 and had a 1.92 ERA and more than 120 strikeouts in 120-plus innings. "Kai is a special player," Hatch said. "She loves the game and has worked hard to be the player that she is today. She has spent many hours in the barn with her dad, Troy. She has played lots of club ball but was never given the chance to be in the circle. It was easy to get her ready for the season. She just wanted a chance." Williams returned nine players from last year's title run. "The leadership really comes from all the girls," Hatch said. "They are a blast to coach. It seems like someone will always step up when needed. They are willing to step up and do whatever they are asked."



Bagdad: Confidence, positive energy, chemistry and multiple leaders are just some of the key ingredients fueling Bagdad's success this year, coach Sarah Morris said. "Holly Myers is our only senior," Morris said. "She has been around the game awhile. Her love for the game makes everyone want to work hard. She is very level headed and always keeps a positive attitude. Briah Williams is a sophomore. She has that can-do-attitude and is an amazing student athlete and works hard always. She leads a lot by example, but has really opened up vocally this year as a leader on our team." Some of the other team's leaders are Lindi Langston, Jocelyn Rodriguez and Nuvia Jauregui. "All three have stepped up this year with their voice and have really helped lead our team along with Holly and Briah," Morris added. "All of these girls are amazing ball players and work hard. It's easy to run practice when you have so many hard working girls on your team that lead by example, and have good attitudes." The team also has its share of unsung heroes. "Cathcer Lindi Langston is an outstanding kid and brings so much fun and laughter to our game," Morris said. "She has had a solid bat all year long and kills it behind the plate. Third baseman Jocelyn Rodriguez is making plays for us and smashing the ball this year. We've seen so much growth in this kid in just a year. She has really stepped up her game this year and does an amazing job for us in the field and in the box. Makeala Mendez, our Left fielder, has really stepped up and made plays for us in the outfield and is making things happen in the batter's box also. Her speed on the bases is killer. Reily Martin, a junior outfielder, has really made things happen for us in big games, moving runners into to scoring position or putting the ball in play so runners can score. Tatum Jeans, Sarah Blanton, Anna Young, Jaylyn Rodriguez, and Kiah Morris all stepped up this year as freshman and have filled spots and done a phenomenal job for us."

Desert Christian: Pitcher Dayna Han and her battery mate, Aimee Lloyd, are just two reasons whey Desert Christian hasn't lost in the past month. "We have a great group of girls this year that really enjoy each other," coach Bob Vance said. "From seniors to freshmen, there is great chemistry and love for each other. All the girls are committed to the team first and then to their own individual needs. This humble, sacrificial attitude has helped us have a good season so far. God honors the humble."

Coach Vance on his seniors and leaders: "Our senior class has extraordinary leaders, never lording it over the other girls. They treat every other as an equal and work hard to include the Baby Ducks in everything we do. Maddy Hebert is a four year starter at first base and plays the position as well as anyone in 1A. Haily Flores is another returning starter and has completely owned center field. Rachel Murray had to miss last year due to some career planning conflicts. However, she has become one of our most productive players. You always want your players to peak at season's end and she is definitely doing that. Perhaps the biggest contributor to our success would have to be Dayna Han. She is having a phenomenal season. Her stats speak for themselves, but they fail to capture Dayna. I have known her since she was in 3rd or 4th grade and she has grown into a beautiful person. Even if her skills were just average, I would want her on any team I coached. Her heart, passion, determination, leadership, humbleness, coachability are all things a coach prays for in a player. Should she choose to play on after high school, she will be a huge asset to her team. One other player that needs to be mentioned is our Baby Duck catcher, Aimee Lloyd. A significant part of Dayna's success is having a catcher that is totally in sync with her. Aimee has done an incredible job of working with Dayna, mixing up pitches and changing locations. She is going to be something very special over the next three years."

Mohave Accelerated: "The team is young but improved as the season wore on. One thing they had all along was a sisterhood," coach Shanda Weiler. "They all get along, support each other on and off the field, and lift each other up whenever they have a rough day or commit an error," Weiler said. Offensively, the team is led by Nancy Keeley (.651 ave.) and Jordin Bernard (.541 ave.). "Both are juniors and have that natural ability to lead their team," Weiler said. "Alyssa Laing, a freshman pitcher, has been a dominant force in the circle and defensively. She is a force to reckon with." Laing had struck out 82 batters in 56 1/3 innings. The unsung heroes of the team have been Emilee Thames, Nancy Keeley, Jezika Kalaitzian, Kaylene Burright, Jordin Bernard, Sonoma Deal, and Bronte Gee. "They have stepped up this year and are leading this team," Weiler said. "Emilee has struggled through some knee injuries and continues to push herself each day on the softball field. Nancy has been solid for us in the batter's box and third and center for us. Jezika and Kaylene are coming off a knee surgery last year and are solid defensively at second and shortstop. Jordin is second in stats for batting and has had a golden glove on the corners. Sonoma has been a block wall behind the plate and each game gets better and better in the batter's box. Bronte is the leader in the outfield, going from left to center, and is having a strong showing in the batter's box."

Valley Union's Violet Morin's fielding percentage was .939. ... Kim Newman, McKenzee James and Bella Wernett were each hitting over .400 for Ray. ... Halee Deskin had scored 40 runs for St. David. ...Antelope Union's Yareli Manriquez and Katlyn Williams were hitting over .600.
