PHOENIX COUNTRY DAY LOOKING FOR A REPEAT; NEW GIRLS CHAMP?

Can Phoenix Country Day repeat as champ?
Will a new champion in 3A emerge for girls?

Those are two of the biggest questions heading into the 3A Conference state championships. The PCD team once again didn't lose a regular season game to a 3A squad.

In fact, the Eagles haven't experienced losing much under coach Andrew Rodin. In the four seasons of the program's existence, PCD has won at least 15 games each year.

Win four more and it'll reach that win mark again but more importantly defend its title. Another team that didn't lose to a 3A team this year was Odyssey Institute, the only 3A team that went undefeated in power ranked games.

Odyssey Institute coach Bryan Green wasn't ready to declare his team as one of the favorites.

"Respectfully, there are a lot of really great teams in our conference," Green said. "Our region alone has six solid teams that were in the playoffs last year. Teams like PCDS, ALA Ironwood and Thatcher are hard-working, talented squads with great coaches. Our hope is to play to the best of our abilities, limit our mistakes and trust each other. When we are able to do that, we will live with the results. And the results have been going well for us so far this year."

For the 3A girls, Benjamin Franklin, Safford and Glendale Prep didn't drop a power ranked game this season.

But this tournament may be up for grabs. Let's take a look at the contenders in each bracket

3A Girls

ALA-West Foothills: The team captains are sophomore Kaimbrey Inman, the state's leading scorer, and the very experienced Tyler Eastman. "Both of these girls are great ball handlers and have a shot to die for," coach Kimberlie Gagle. Sophia Kemling, the team's only senior and soon to be a valedictorian, is being recruited to play soccer. The 11-5 team is in its first season as an AIA varsity program. "Our girls have been so successful this season because we have heart. We play with pure positivity and fun."

Benjamin Franklin: "The biggest reason for our success is the chemistry these girls have created," coach John Greksa. "They are a young team and have made plenty of mistakes, but they never let down and always pick each other back up. Delin Peterson and Jaspvr Rocha are the team's top scorers. "Delin has the quickest first step that I have ever seen, and Jaspvr has amazing footwork," coach said. "Katie Moore is our playmaker and has amazing field awareness. And Rachel Greksa is our rock that holds everything together. She has amazing speed and is a lockdown defender." Crismon: "There is lots of excitement as we are a new school and only have freshmen and sophomores," coach John Roberts said. Roberts and his staff moved from Perry High School and have been coaching for a number of years. "Sydney Droen is a playmaker that can play any position on the field," Roberts said. "Kailyn Revolt is a pure goal scoring machine. Jaycee Walker is an incredible defender that can play anywhere. Cadence Narancic is the captain that controls the defense."

Glendale Prep: "The increasing success the last three seasons of the Lady Griffins varsity soccer team is rooted in growth," coach Robert Ramsey. "We created a strong JV team in which we developed new and young players. The current core group of varsity players started together three years ago as freshman and sophomores. It was a building year with minimal upper classmen. But the girls stayed together and developed their own chemistry and unique style of play." The team's leaders are senior captain Diane Scalise and junior Rosie Ayer. "Diane knows our game plan and translates it to the younger players. She steps up when the need arises and guides the team through adversity. Diane is a well-rounded player. She has played every position for us, and exceeded at all. She can score goals, assist and excels defensively. As a defensive midfielder and center back no opponent gets through her. Rosie is another exceptional leader. Rosie reads the game and helps with tactical adjustments. She helps translate these adjustments to her teammates. On the ball, Rosie is as skillful as they come." The team lost a key member in senior defender Ella Smith (knee injury) during a preseason game.

Gilbert Classical: "Trust, positive feedback and support," coach Oscar Medina said. "These are among some of the most important aspects of our team community. Knowing how to foster these in young adults for

a successful future on-and-off the field is the reason we are here now." The team's leaders are Sam Haug, Tess Bloxham and Heidi and Shiloh Ulrickson, a US Youth Olympic Development Program player. "They have stepped up to lead us through a season full of challenges and opportunities by supporting and teaching each other, and managing how to respond to feedback in order to have a positive outcome," coach said.

Gilbert Christian: "This year the Gilbert Christian Lady Knights are back with young talent and now finding their identity as a club," coach Hector Arellana said. The team's leaders are senior Olivia Petree (defensive presence, leadership), sophomore Caprice Chiuchiolo (excellent footwork, creative in playmaking opportunities and scoring), freshman Mackenzie Kiser (goal scoring machine), Jaidyn Wilson (attacking vision and box to box defending), and Daniella Orellana. Daniella, last season's captain, returned this year from an ACL injury. "As her dad, I'm so proud to be alongside her through all the ups and downs," Hector said. "From learning to walk, run and kick all over again. She has returned stronger, smarter and more passionate to play the game that she loves."

Phoenix Country Day: "We have emphasized working together and helping each other grow as a whole," coach Megan Fry said. "It's not just about one player, it's about the entire team. We've really tried to focus on having fun and enjoying the process instead of only being results driven." Elle Mullard and Emma Sorensen are the team's leaders. "Elle is a great vocal leader whose energy is unmatched," Fry said. "Emma has really stepped into a great leadership role in our back line, and she's an amazing portrayal of lead by example."

Safford: "We have strong leadership from our seniors, and we have gifted young players who are willing to listen and learn," coach E.J. Romero said. "They have done many things this season to bond together and become a family." Safford's leaders are Sophia Romero, Olivia Madrid, Elysia Barringer, Samantha Foote, Luz Mendoza, Trinity Dominguez, and Lydia Marin. The team also plays an "exceptional" young player in Tashoney 'TK' Kniffin, a member of the San Carlos Apache Tribe.

Sabino: "Our success really comes down to the environment that is created at Sabino," coach Mackenzie Samuelsen said. "We provide an excellent education to our student athletes. With this in mind it's natural our student athletes would find the same level in their out of classroom activities." The team returned nine players from last year's state final but carries only two seniors, Alycia Skog and Athena Huggins. "Athena brings a level and an edge that is uncommon," coach said. "It isn't simply on the field, but there is a lot of respect for her voice in the squad. Alycia has the total approach. She brings a level of maturity that can see forward, supporting the team through difficult times (fitness) knowing/trusting herself and her teammates to rise up."



Scottsdale Prep: “I believe we’ve been so successful this season because of the vast amount of encouragement and intuition within our group,” Alexander Jassemidis said. “We came out this season hoping to create more of a brand and identity for ourselves and it looks like we are finally finding our true chemistry. But that all starts with the encouragement the girls continue to give each other, especially with so many newly competitive soccer players that we have.” The team’s leaders are three of its seniors, Katie Holford, Aimee Bogosian and Madison Koetz. “They all possess talents and skills within themselves that create a great triangle of leadership duties,” coach said. “Katie brings the aggression and fury. Aimee brings the confidence and the if-they-can-do-it-we-can-do-it-better attitude, and Madison brings organization and communication to the team.”

Thatcher: “Our team has had a great season so far, and we attribute our success to all the hard work the girls put in at practice,” coach Sara Holmes said. “This group of girls works day in and day out without any complaints and with go getter attitudes. They are anxious to learn and work to increase their skill levels and talents every day.” Thatcher’s leaders are Matti Lopeman, Lindsey McMasters, Sedona Nelson, Ady Smith and Rachel Richardson. “Matti and Lindsey use their experience and knowledge to direct and coordinate our defense, keeping them positioned correctly and engaged in the game,” Holmes said. “Our midfield is led by Sedona, who keeps a level head and provides great defensive tackles while moving the ball smoothly to our offense. Offensively, we are led by Ady and Rachel. These two are vocal, calling and directing most passes and offensive plays. Ady possess fantastic footwork skills and a killer leg while Rachel is a powerhouse on the wing.”

Veritas Prep: “Our team has great team chemistry and knows how to encourage each other to get out of funks when games start rough or to keep it up when the score is going our way,” coach Kristi Seltzer said. “We focus on conditioning a lot and passing, which has come in handy during a lot of our games.” Rory Klocke and Analie Conner are the captains. “Our senior class is a great group of leaders who have been together since their freshman year,” Seltzer said. “They have all stepped up as leaders and starters, especially our captains Rory and Analie. They have taken their captain roles to another level and they know how to bring their team together on and off the field.”

3A Boys

ALA-Ironwood: “Our team this year has had the best year in program history due to strong senior captain/leadership of Isaiah Pensis-Ramirez, Kevin Chacon and Trey Van Skyke and the overall hard work and dedication from everyone on the team,” coach John Axtell said. “Every member, from our starters to backups, pushes every day to make each other better.” Three foreign exchange students, Vertti Tuisku, Samuel Cruz and Lorenz Schmidt, anchor the team’s back line. “Isaiah, Kevin and Trey have an amazing work ethic, strong leadership, really strong knowledge of the game and really built great chemistry from the years of club together and high school soccer.”

Florence: “We focus on culture to start the year and made it clear that attitude determines our altitude,” coach Michael Curtiss said. “Everything on our team starts with teamwork, effort, coachability, and accountability. As a result of this focus we have grown into a family and the guys who started the year lacking skills have become assets and are growing.” The team’s leaders are Michael Molina, Alejandro Suarez-Montoya and Ty O’Rourke. “Michael is a competitor and is always looking to build younger players up. Alejandro is quiet, calm, an amazing passer and plays soccer 12 months a year. Ty has a very high soccer IQ, is intense, motivates others, and can dissect any play.”

Gilbert Christian: “This year we have been blessed with a balanced team that is very young, with only 2 seniors, so everyone on the field and bench is equally important and we are not relying on a few players to carry the team,” coach Devon Dickinson said. “This has forced us to play good soccer and everyone shares the burden and benefit of success. We have two seniors that lead well, but many of the juniors and even a sophomore have stepped up to be vocal on the field and hold everyone accountable. Accountability is something that is promoted in our team and everyone has the right and obligation to hold each other accountable on and off the field.”

Gilbert Classical: “The soccer program that I have managed at GCA offers an amazing opportunity for student athletes who seek to improve their social, athletic and academic skills in order to create more conscientious citizens in our community,” coach Oscar Medina said. “What they learn from my program is that soccer is an important building block to a healthy, productive, and responsible life.” Krystian Gary, Alex Lara-Perez,

and Kalel Mendoza are the team’s leaders. “They have stepped up to lead us through a season full of challenges and opportunities by supporting and teaching each other and managing how to respond to feedback in order to have a positive outcome,” Medina said. This is the second consecutive year in the playoffs for the team.

Glendale Prep: “Our success has come from years of commitment and dedication to improve all players, not just those labeled as starters,” said third-year coach Leo Lankford. “While a good portion of our team play club soccer, we also have a large portion who have only played school soccer. The commitment by those who play club, to help improve the skill of those who do not, have helped bring the overall skill level from a 3-10 team my first year in charge to a 5-6 team last year.” This year’s team won the school’s first soccer region championship. This season’s leaders are Hudson Grotte, Dante Gonzalez, and Sammy Squires. “Hudson is one of my most experienced players and is one of the first people at practice and one of the last to leave. Dante has a great vocal presence. Sammy has an attitude and presence that is contagious to other players.” An injury to a key player forced Glendale Prep to move field player Aymen Neazi to GK.

Odyssey Institute: “We have been working hard at Odyssey to build a competitive soccer team,” coach Bryan Green said. “We’ve been blessed with young men that are dedicated to the process of improvement. We lifted weights all summer and really grew as a family culture.” The team is led by senior captains Nathan Hamlin, Cayden Hart and Elijah Moore as well as Omar Lopez and Moises Nava Jr. and goalkeepers Dylan Mapston and Noah Anholm. “We all row in the same direction as a unit,” Green said. “We possess the ball, maintain the ball and score with the best. We are lucky to have confidence in our ability but no ego.” The team hasn’t lost a home game in two years.

Phoenix Country Day: “We have a talented team with 12 seniors coming off a state championship run last year,” coach Andrew Rodin said. Alex Sondergaard and Jake Gregory lead the team up front, Jonah Kaplan and Adam Burns control the midfield, Ari Kreisberger and Parker Milliken are the defensive stalwarts. Kaplan is approaching 100 goals and 100 assists for his career.

Valley Christian: “This is a very close-knit group of players,” Paul Barker said. “The jokes and looseness can be found before every training and game. There is a palpable sense of unity and brotherhood. The team has very much embraced a growth mindset, believing we can and will improve throughout the season, which we have done both individually and collectively. This team never gives up and is not shaken when challenges are thrown our way. In games, when we have conceded goals, the team responds well every time.” Brennen Horvath, Carson Rowe and Ethan Gomez are the team’s leaders. “Brennen is a strong presence for us on the field, both with his play and his voice. Carson anchors us in the back, constantly guiding our defense to stifle attacks. Ethan is the energizer bunny for us, setting the tone with his physical play and relentless work ethic.”

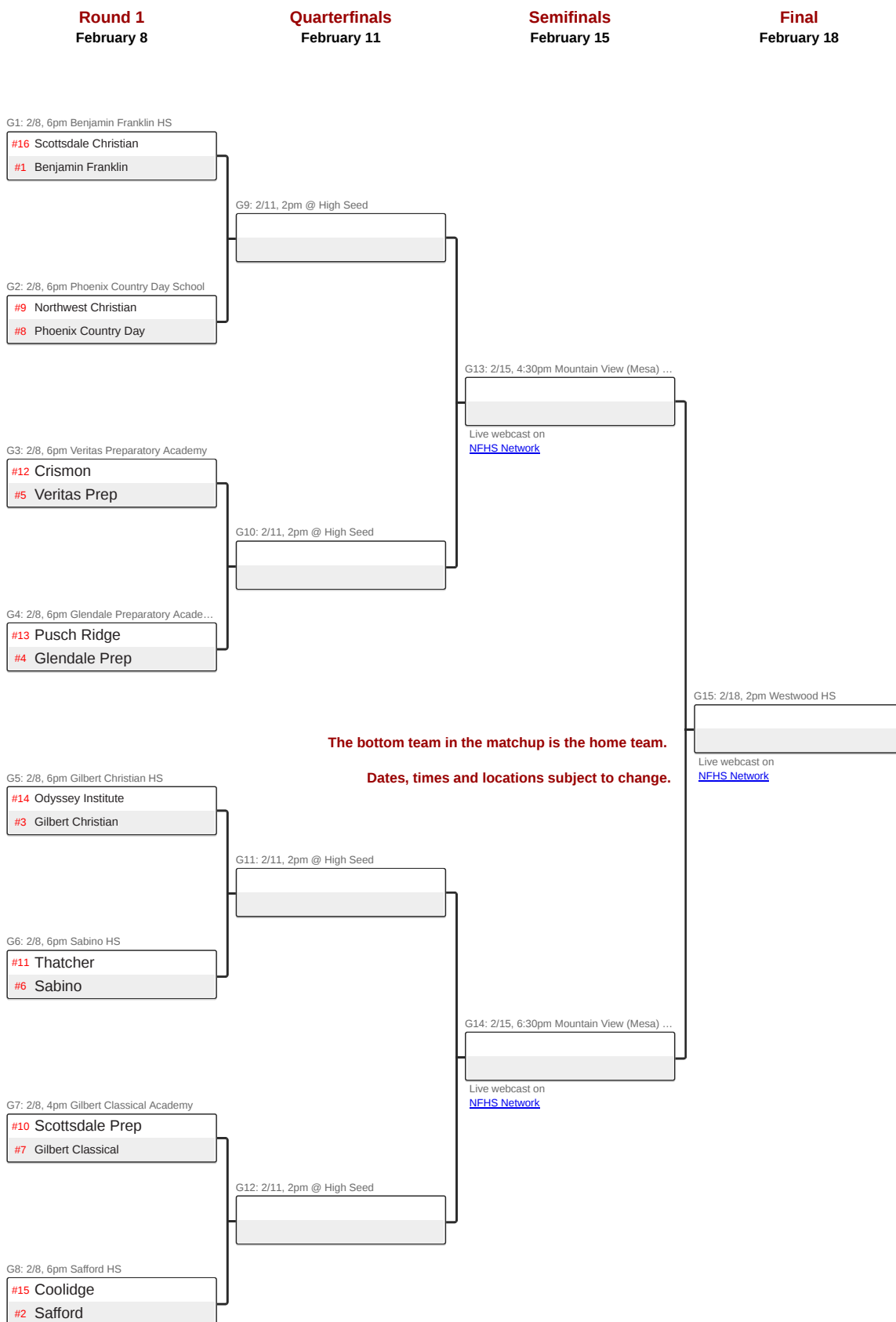

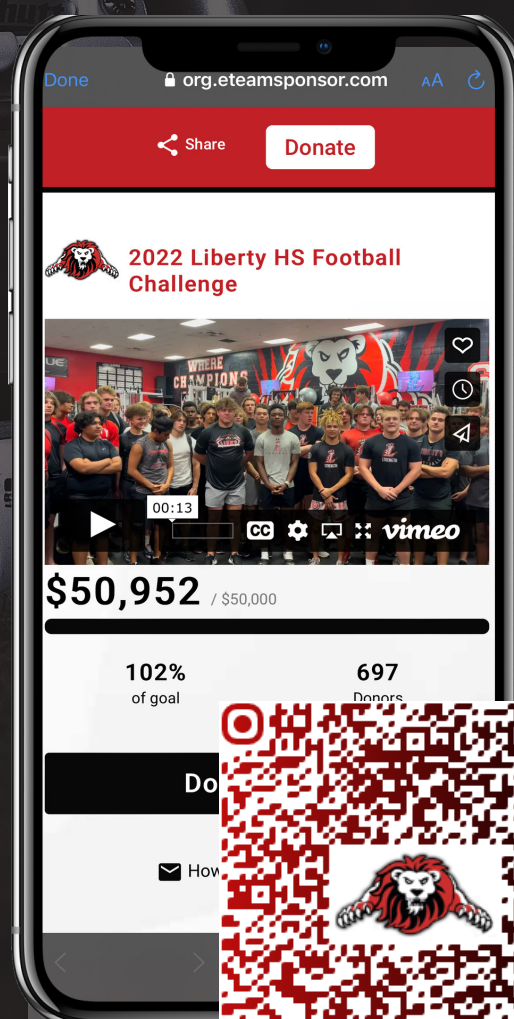

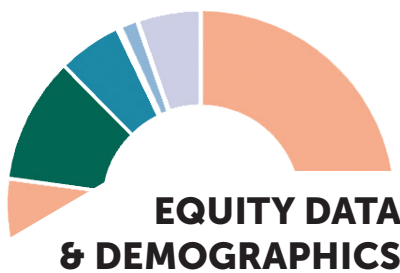
