

# DON'T EXPECT ANYONE TO RUN AWAY WITH 1A BOYS CROWN

The Gregory School, the state's top seed, went undefeated against 1A competition this regular season.

North Valley Christian, the No. 2 seed, is the defending champ.

But all signs are pointing to a very competitive 16-team tournament this season.

"There are a lot of great teams in the 1A this year, and we will have to play our best basketball in February," North Valley Christian coach Randy Walker said.

North Valley Christian reached the title game during three of the last four years, winning twice, with Walker at the helm.

But this season, Walker's boys battled through injuries to four of its top six players, including a season ending knee injury to 6-4, four-year starter Austin Kraemer, one of four returning starters from last year's title team.

"Through all of that, we have started to get our legs back and cohesiveness, as we are more healthy now than at any time during the season," Walker said.

Coach Craig Everson's The Gregory School program's last championship seasons came in 2018 and 2019.

At 15 games, Everson's team holds the longest current win streak in 1A. But it only beat last year's runner-up, Baboquivari, by a point and defeated North Valley Christian by two this season. Baboquivari's only three 1A losses were by a combined 12 points.

"Our success has been based on tremendous work ethic—much of it done in the offseason—and amazing teamwork," Everson said. "Our kids truly play for one another. There are no egos as evidenced by the fact that we play 9-12 boys in our regular rotation."

None of The Gregory School's players are averaging more than 19 minutes per game.

"All the boys in our rotation are able to play at a fast pace, both offensively and defensively, which tends to wear out our opponents who usually only play six-seven man rotations," Everson said.

## Team tournament notes

**The Gregory School:** Five of the team's seniors have played for the K-12 school since they were in fifth grade. The Hawks may have the tallest 1A front court, with 6-5 freshman Razin Smith, 6-5 sophomore Nitai Buchler, 6-4 senior Kevin Hendershott. Smith is averaging 16 points and 10 rebounds in about 18 minutes per game. The six guards on the team are all excellent on ball defenders, coach Craig Everson said. Guards Devin Dawson (8 ppg in 15 minutes), sophomore Jackson Dickinson (10 ppg game during team's current win streak) and junior Justus Turner (8 ppg in 18 minutes) have 'emerged' as scorers. "Our underclassmen do the bulk of our scoring, but our seniors are so special on defense and solid running the offense," coach said.

**North Valley Christian:** Stopping guard Bobby Rodriguez is a chore. The junior can score and distribute. The team learned some valuable lessons while dealing with its share of injuries. "It has taught our team a lot about dealing with adversity," coach Walker said. "Nothing comes easy. We have to earn everything we get. We have to rely on each other and strengthen our relationships. Players have been asked to step up that may not have had the opportunity before but have done so as a result of our injuries."

**Desert Christian:** Coach Iram Alday recently told his boys and their families that this will be his final tour. He has served the program for 23 seasons, 15 as the head coach and has a 253-176 record heading into the playoffs. His 2023-24 squad is 24-5, and two of his players, Jonathan Brown and Tyson Dobbins, reached the 1,000 career point mark this season. Desert Christian is home to the 1A's current assists leader, senior Adam Vavala. This season, Alday's team has wins over 3A teams Fountain Hills and Parker and 2A teams Horizon Honors and Mohave Accelerated. It lost to 2A's Phoenix Country Day in three overtimes in the Phoenix Country Day Desert Classic tournament final and in the semifinals of the ALA Coyote Invitational semifinal. Along with Vavala, fellow seniors Bennett Vondrak and Bennett Vondrak and sophomore Tyson Dobbins are the leaders of the team. "Coaching these young men is a joy and privilege because they are competitors and just a good group of guys," coach said.

**Anthem Prep:** The team's five starters were each averaging between 12 and eight points per game and a couple of bench players also are contributing. "They all play really hard and share the ball," coach James Sinner said. "If someone isn't having a great game, someone else always seems to step up. Any one of seven guys could lead us in scoring on a given night. I think it's this true team culture that has made us successful." The group's offseason sacrifices and support from parents have also led to its winning campaign. "I'm extremely proud of this group," coach said. "They are high academic achievers, and they play extremely hard. They are an easy team to root for."

**El Capitan/Academy:** A first-year coach, Joseph Timpson, seven seniors and having everybody buy in to Timpson's approach are paying off. "We excel in rebounding and place great importance on making the most of every possession we acquire," coach said. "Under the guidance of our seven seasons seniors, we exhibit mental discipline and thrive in high-pressured situations. We believe in accountability and extreme ownership over the things that we can control." Denim and Zedekye White, Ethan and Monte Hammon, and Noah Dockstader are leading the way. "As the 7th seed, we embrace the role of the underdog in this tournament," Timpson said. "We firmly believe that we can go toe-to-toe with any opponent, and we are eager to prove it. Our approach to competition is marked by a combination of sportsmanship and humility, cherishing every opportunity to compete for a championship."

**Joseph City:** "This team is willing to work hard and participate in summer basketball events," coach Eric Miller said. "They have a positive attitude and are unselfish." Sophomores Eli James (10.5 ppg, 5.0 rpg) and Cort Miller (12.3 ppg) and senior Jared Layden (11.1 ppg) are leading the charge for the Wildcats. "They put in the work and are good leaders," Miller added.

**Antelope Union:** The Rams went undefeated in the West Region. The team is 15-4, and it's the first time it's had a winning record since 2016. There are plenty of reasons for the turnaround. For starters, the upperclassmen have stepped up, beginning with captains Abraham Moreno, Kenan Ragels and Israel Ruiz. "They set the tone every practice, and the rest of the team follows along," coach Angel Esparza said. The MVPs so far have been the team's leading scorers, Caleb Martinez and Ragels. Holding down the fort in the post is Alizay Figueroa. Israel Ruiz is a floor general. "I would also like to shoutout my assistant coaches, (defensive coordinator) Sonny Figueroa and (player development coach) William Whitley," coach said.

Williams: "My coaching career spans 25 years, all in California," coach Michael Tyler said. "I have coached in 3,000 student schools. I have coached D-I players and against players who have gone on to play in the NBA. No experience in those years has been more enjoyable, fulfilling than my experience at Williams." Tyler implemented a strenuous conditioning program and assembled an experienced staff. On the court, leading his receptive crew are Nikoli Cody, JP Echeveria and the Trimble, Cade and Brody. "Nikoli is a very skilled offensive player who has worked hard on his defensive skills to become a much better all-around player," Tyler said. "JP is a team leader on and off the court. His leadership has been a big help in this year's transition. Cade is a sophomore, a ball magnet and a warrior. He is a constant inside scorer and post player. He may weigh 150 pounds soaking wet, but he still manages to dominate the paint. Brody is a player I can look to to fill whatever task needs to be filled."

**Basis Flagstaff:** The Yetis (19-6) are a win away from the program's first 20-win season. They are led by a 1A Conference Player of the Year candidate, co-captain Jack Engelthaler. The 6-2 senior is averaging 29.6 points per game and is shooting 47 percent. He also leads the team in rebounds (11.6 pg), steals (5.0 pg) and blocks (2.7 pg) despite not playing most of the fourth quarters because of blowouts. "We have won games this year because he simply refuses to let us lose; most especially demonstrated by his performance against city rival Northland Prep (65-61 win)," coach Chris Bayer said. Rowdy McGourin's points and defense also are contributing to the team's success. Same goes with Daniel Quiroz. The 'unsung hero' of the team is Connor Ferguson, who does all the dirty work for the team. There's plenty of depth on the bench. The program has won two region titles in a row and is making its fourth consecutive trip to the playoffs. Bayer is approaching his 100th career win.

#### More notes

Sophomores Damare Dosela and Channing Wilson are each averaging 14 points per game for **Ft. Thomas**. ... Senior Devin Antone is averaging 23.4 points per game and shooting 53 percent for **Baboquivari**. ... **Ray's** Joseph Morales (14 ppg) and Mark Chester (10.3) are the team's leading scorers. ... **Cicero Prep**, the East Region champ, was led by the region's top scorer and rebounder, David Yourkoski (15.9 pg, 8.2 rpg). ... Mogollon only dresses three seniors, Kyson Owens, Brian King and Gabe Talerico. ... **Hayden** 5-11 center Keiston Pool is averaging a 11.7 points and 10.6 rebounds per game. ... According to **Salome's** MaxPreps page, 6-3, 215-pound sophomore Chris Smith has made 54 of his 56 shots. Jibrán Castillo is averaging 16.4 points per game for his team.



# ST. DAVID GIRS LOOKING TO END TWO-PLUS DECADE TITLE DROUGHT IN 1A

Twenty-two years.

That's how long it's been since St. David hoisted a gold ball. Can it end that championship-less streak this year?

It certainly played like the favorite this season, going 24-2 in the regular season without a loss to a 1A team. But to land the big prize, St. David might have to upend some programs that have ascended to power in recent years.

For starters, the young but talented Rock Point Cougars are the defending champs. There's also Joseph City, last year's runner-up, which wouldn't mind meeting St. David for a third time this season and finally winning.

And then there's also Fort Thomas, a final four program in the last four years and 2021 champ. Ft. Thomas lost a close battle, 50-48, to St. David on Dec. 23.

"This is a talented team that is also extremely young, but they have not let this get in the way of getting better," said Ft. Thomas coach Lee Haws about his team. "They work hard, trust each other and have fun."

## Team tournament notes

**St. David:** "This season we have been able to find success through our effort on defense," coach Matthew Brogan said. "We have done a good job of forcing tough shots and making it tough for teams to score. When we are at our best we also do a good job of limiting teams on the offensive glass." The team MVPs are seniors, guard Mayla Trejo, post player Anissa Jacquez and guard Halee Deskins. "Mayla is a strong ball handler who can shoot the ball from outside," coach said. "She is our leader on offense and gets us where we need to go. She's been great at getting into passing lanes on defense and forcing turnovers. Anissa can score the ball inside efficiently. She has been excellent at protecting the rim and making things difficult around the basket for opposing teams. She also does an excellent job rebounding the basketball. Halee does a lot for us that doesn't always show up in the stat sheet. She's our leader on defense. She picks up ball pressures of opposing point guards. She makes it really tough for other teams to initiate their offense cleanly. She dives for loose balls and always brings really good energy when she is on the court."

**Joseph City:** The team is receiving contributions from multiple players in multiple ways. The other neat thing about this squad is that four sisters start, and they each lead the team in different categories. Meet the Niells: Ava (rebound leader), April (field goals and free throws), Amber (scoring), and Audrey (steals). “They work and play well together,” coach Dan Bushman said. But the strong family ties don’t end there. The team’s sixth man, Samantha Jesmer, and the team’s assists leader, Gabrielle Jesmer, are twin sisters. The Jesmers have a younger sister, McKenzie, who is also on the team. “Our team is a very talented group of ladies that are willing to do what it takes to be successful,” coach said. “I have a great coaching staff, and the girls listen and do what we as coaches ask them to do. They have bought into the program and do not sit idly by waiting for success to come - they go out and get it. Everyone on our team has a very important role to play, not just the girls that are on the court. Each of the girls, managers, and coaches perform their role to the best of their abilities and that is what makes us successful. “Our girls are great but, without a doubt, we would not have the success we are enjoying without the support of our parents and families, school administration and staff, and our great community.”

**Ft. Thomas:** Three freshmen subs, Kynnedee Bryce, Corey Cody and Jamie Johnson, play regularly. Three sophomores, post player Makayla Chapman, second leading scorer Kaylee Benally, and starting point guard Raeleigh Hawkins, also get playing time. Those youngsters are leaning on junior Adaia Lorenzo and senior Tyesha Wilson for guidance. Wilson is the team’s points and steals leader and has already scored 1,000 career points. This is Lorenzo’s first year on varsity but plays multiple positions and can handle the ball.

**Lincoln Prep:** This is the best ever seeding (No. 5) for the program and fifth consecutive year reaching the playoffs. Coach Andy Krebs credited assistants Torry Mills and Destiny Mount for helping the program continue its winning ways. Danna Cubero is the ‘heart and soul’ of the team, Alexis Ortiz is the defensive stopper, and Eva Rodriguez’s versatility also have been key to the team’s success. Senior co-captain Sarah Hagerman has also been instrumental for the Lightning this season. “Overall this team has been getting better each year since a few started every game since their freshman year,” Krebs said. “The entire program (JV, varsity) has really bought into the team concept, play very unselfishly and really enjoy being around everyone.”

**Salome:** The 22-6 Frogs have won the most games since 2013. The year’s team is loaded with senior experience. The unselfish bunch is led by junior guard Grecia Leon, 6-1 senior center Kaniece Thomas and senior forward Aalyssa Flores. Thomas, the defensive enforcer, has more than 500 career blocks and is second in scoring. Flores’ leadership, defense and rebounding have been

‘critical’ for the team’s defensive rotations. “We have great assistant coaches who have really helped develop our young players and gotten consistency out of our veterans,” coach Bryan McCarty said.

**Desert Christian:** Despite starting one senior, the Eagles are a win away from win No. 20. Four freshmen play on a regular basis. Even with its youth, coach Richard Peddy said his squad has been one of the most diligent practice teams he’s had. “They run without complaint and listen diligently to instruction, probably because they have so much to learn,” Peddy said. Senior center Anika Mulkey and freshman Addison Jones have been leading the way. Mulkey has been revelation. The 5-8 center has been playing basketball for less than two years. But she’s a quick learner and also the fastest player on the team. The young Jones is already the team’s best defender and ball handler, coach said. “Both Anika and Addi are tenacious and fearless,” Peddy said.

**Duncan:** Eldon Merrell is enjoying watching his team grow. He’s aware of the improvements his team needs to make, but the fruits of Duncan’s labor are starting to pay off. The team garnered the 9th seed in the tournament and will finish with its first winning seasons in eight years. The team’s ‘emotional’ MVP is Aubrey Evans, and Rachel Sumner is a ‘rebound machine.’ “Aubrey is the perfect example of just working hard every play,” Merrell said. “She always seems to come up with defensive stops and lose balls.” The team’s scoring leaders are junior Camille Miller and Emily Kempton, and one of them has to be on for Duncan to win, Merrell said. And if both of them are on, watch out.

#### More notes

**North Valley Christian’s** leading scorer is a freshman, Triniti Terracciano (15.4 ppg). ... Kara Baptisto is averaging 18.9 points per game for **Baboquivari**. ... **St. Michael**, the North Region champ, has won 11 of its past 12 games. ... Violet Barlow is averaging 5.6 assists for **El Capitan/Academy**. ... Brianna Majalca was leading **Patagonia** with 7.2 rebounds per game. ... **Rock Point** has won three of the past four 1A title games. The program is 16-9 and has won its past five games with only two seniors on its roster. ... **Mogollon** junior Heidi Parry led her region in assists (4.2 pg) and was second with close to five assists a game. ... **Valley Union** has won seven more games than it did last year. ... **Williams’** Kai Mortensen is averaging close to 20 points a game.
