



### RINSE AND REPEAT? DEFENDING CHAMPS HAMILTON, IRONWOOD APPEAR READY TO MAKE ANOTHER RUN AT TEAM CROWNS

Hamilton appeared in the previous three team D-I finals, taking home the championship hardware twice.

Ironwood hasn't lost to a Division II team since 2022.

After what they accomplished this season, the perennial favorites aren't quite ready, it appears, to turn in their crowns just yet.

But plenty of talented teams are capable of pulling off an upset at state in the Division I and II fields. Here's a look at some of the contenders, beginning with the favorites:

#### **Division I**

The Hamilton Huskies went 42-2 during the last three seasons and are 14-0 this year. "The factor is the team culture we've built," said coach Lauren Rosales about her program's success over the last four years. "In practice, these girls are warriors. They challenge and push each other to the point of exhaustion, which is exactly how you get better. But the second we step onto the court for a match, that energy flips to fierce support." Nihira 'Nini' Sane was the D-I runner-up in singles and is undefeated this year. "Nihira is hungry for that state title," Rosales said. "She came up just a tad bit short last year. This year she's improved her ability to adjust mid-match. She reads her opponent well, and she is good at identifying what she needs to do mid-match in order to control the rallies. Nini's speed and agility allow her to cover the entire court with ease.

"Something not everyone knows about Nini is that she's spent 10 years mastering Kathak, an intricate classical dance form that demands immense discipline, grace and rhythmic precision. Her ability to balance training for badminton, training for dance, a rigorous academic schedule, and multiple clubs is truly incredible. Oh, and she's a national merit semifinalist. Nini is one-of-a-kind." Shreya Deshpande and Katheryn Yi were the doubles D-I runner-up last year but are playing with different partners this year. "Kat and Hayley (Koh) have put in a lot of work this year," Rosales said. "They are hungry to the get on that podium for doubles. Both of those teams complement each other so well. They move around the court well together, and they communicate well. Mid-match you can observe them taking a quick second to reset and change their game plan. I'm so excited to watch them compete at the state tournament." The program added Mark Yi and Albert Sue to its coaching staff. "They have put in so many hours helping our girls get better," Rosales said.

Sunnyslope graduated four seniors from last season's D-I runner-up team. "The hard work and dedication from the girls," said veteran coach Sarah Schlesinger about finishing 13-1 during the regular season and returning to the postseason. Layton Hunter, the team's No. 1 singles player, and No. 2 Zoe Staten have been the team's MVPs. "Bryn Daley has played at 3 and the 1 doubles and fought so hard to win some really tough games," Schlesinger said. "She has impressed us a great deal. Brianna Valente has also shown brightly at the 4 spot and 2 doubles. Our juniors have really stepped up for us as well. Lelia Cody and Molly Nordstrom have helped us keep our depth this season."

Despite some injuries and some busy student athlete schedules, Desert Vista clinched a top-10 D-I state tourney seed. "I've never seen a group of kids with more on their plates than this team," coach Gabriella Nakada said. "We always say the "student" comes first in "student-athlete" and that is very much true for this team. Many times we will miss players for matches and practices when they need to do homework for their many AP courses. When this occurs for a team with a relatively small roster and players with limited experience, this can be difficult." Desert Vista has reached the D-I team semifinals the last two seasons. "Although not every player on my team has played every year, they were a high school student. They have each put in the time to try and improve not only in practice, but during matches as well," coach said. "This is also only possible with the support of the parents and my wonderful coaching staff." The team's No. 1, Lian Pan, is just a junior but has been a strong force and role model, Nakada said. No. 2 Jaymie Larney has stepped into a leadership role this year. The positivity that senior Alexandra Lopez brings to the court is contagious. "I've never met a more responsible player in all the years I have coached," coach said. "She is always cheering on her teammates, even the coaches. She is always proactive with helping set up and take down the courts at the beginning and end of practices and will always ask how she can help."

Highland carries six seniors on varsity who go all out in matches and during practices, coach Derrick Donaldson said. "Our team is so together," he said. "We have our moments, but we try to keep it as fun as possible." This is the third consecutive year that the program reached the 10-win mark. "All

of our girls have their moments of being our MVP," Donaldson said. "It just depends on the day. All of our girls have stepped up at one moment or two in our season and that is what has made us good."

Mountain Ridge lost a key role player, Mrudula Yellajosyula, to injury at the start of the year but rebounded, winning eight of its final 10 regular season matches. "I would say our consistency has helped the most," coach Adam Korman said. "We might not have overachieved this season, but we certainly didn't underachieve. We have won the games we should win." The team's MVPs have been seniors Bhavana Vinodh, Aditi Bhat and Luci McDonald, who have set the tone, Korman said. The program hasn't experienced a losing record in its last seven seasons. Eileen Lin (sophomore), Saanvi Kandapalli (sophomore), and Greeshma Sabbam (junior) have stepped up big time this year," coach added. "This is their first year on varsity and have made an immediate impact for our team."

Skyline finished its regular season with its best record, 13-1, since 2016. But it was tough year emotionally for the squad, as some family members of the players passed away. "Pushing through that isn't always the easiest," coach llaney Conway said. "However, in those times our team came together to be supportive and push those players to see their best potential.

"I think everyone came hungry this year to make Skyline a team that should be recognized. Their work on the courts have definitely proved that." No. 1 Lyneah Peterson and No. 2 Mary Umphrey have been the team's MVPs. "Lyneah's energy in games is one to be recognized," Conway said. "She plays the game in her unique way and anyone who watches leaves impressed with how she is able to do what she does. She definitely doesn't play like your typical varsity 1. Her overall record this year was 16-6. Mary is the definition of a well-rounded player. She is able to take charge when needed. She motivates and cheers on the team and is always ready to work as hard as possible to get the win or make a comeback when losing. Her record this season was 24-2." Another player who filled a leadership void this year was Tiffani Ramirez. Ramirez always seems to be helping the younger players in the program and motivating everyone on the team, coach said.

Sandra Day O'Connor's No. 1 and 2, captains Aubrey Baker and Nicolina Klauer, suffered ankle injuries midseason. It was a setback, but No. 3 Jessie Estrella, No. 4 Destiny Nguyen, No. 5 Taylor Moon, No. 6 Madison Fulmer and the rest of the program stepped up their game to help the team win 10 regular season team matches. Nguyen is just a freshman. "She has worked hard this season," coach Paula Cappelletti said. "She loves the sport and works hard. I am looking forward to her future in badminton."

Mesa Mountain View suffered a big loss when No. 2, Ava Francis, injured a knee early in the season. But the team bounced back. "Determination, adaptability and strong leadership from our top players have driven our success along with younger players stepping up when needed," coach Teresa Lasalle said. The team MVPs have been No. 1 Sophie Castleton, who is an all-around skill level talent who will return to the state tournament this year, coach said. Francis eventually returned to the team despite still feeling some discomfort. "She showed a lot of grit and commitment," Lasalle said. Freshman Marli "Lion Heart" Chipps was one of the players who stepped up when Francis went down.

#### **Division II**

Ironwood, the defending two-time D-II champ, has a new coach, Amy Hutter. "My girls were taught well by the previous coach and have helped me learn the many different rules for both singles and doubles play," Hutter said. "I have reached out to the old coach many times and have discussed questions and concerns that I have had throughout the season. He has been a great mentor. I have also leaned on other professionals in the community to help me learn different drills to do to help my athletes continue to improve. Knowing that I would be taking over a team with such a winning tradition was very overwhelming. I have spent countless hours watching videos on how to run drills for footwork, how to condition the athletes correctly and to teach them to swing a racket correctly. I have spent many hours in the gym with other professional badminton players, watching them play and coach and learning the game myself. I still have a lot to learn and I look forward to the journey." Only one senior is on the team, but it still won the Peoria Region. Sophia Tijore and Madison Hunter are the team's MVPs. The team's lone senior, Hayden Flores, has played a key role as the No. 6. No. 5 Bryanna Moser, a sophomore, is the youngest player on the team and has also "been a bright

Sunrise Mountain didn't allow a couple of obstacles from recording its ninth consecutive winning season. No. 3 Gracen Thomas is hustling her way around her campus almost every day to play for her school's flag and badminton teams during the fall. Brenna Riley can't attend the first part of practice because of her busy but rewarding schedule at a technical school. But the No. 2 is doing all she can to help her team succeed. The team lost its No. 3, Jaycee Carter, to an ACL offseason injury. She took third in doubles last year with her teammate at state. Carter, a senior, is coach Michele Carter's daughter. "Based on last year, which I know there could be small changes, she would've been our number two singles player this year and part of our number one doubles team," Michele said.

"It has been hard on the both of us, her not being able to play. But having said that this team has stepped up and done incredibly well this season. Each player has contributed to our success without skipping a beat." It appears that Sunrise Mountain has received valuable contributions from almost every player. "I'm just really proud of this team and all the work that they've put in," Michele said. "I do have open gym over the summer and many of them come in and put in the work there too. The majority of my players are multi-sport athletes. They are going to badminton practice after school and then heading to softball or soccer practice that same evening. Many times, the parents are taking them straight from our matches to their next practice. They are great athletes and put in the time in their sport as well as in the classroom. I feel really blessed to be able to coach such a great group of girls."

Prescott's chase for that elusive state team title continues. The Badgers, led by 11th-year coach Bobbi Yoder, finished its 2025 regular season campaign with a 14-0 record. "The team continues to embody the values of hard work, unity and integrity that defines Prescott athletics," Yoder said. The team returned six experienced players from last year's state semifinal team. Those six are No. 1 Annabelle Courtney, No. 2 Claire Long, No. 4 Lucy Townsend, No. 7 Liv Norman, and No. 8 Ashlyn Red. "All ten girls deserve to play because they've all shown up and worked hard to improve not only themselves, but each other as well," said Yoder. "When you have that big of a number on varsity, they all have to buy in to the 'we versus me' mentality. They've done that beautifully — recognizing that unity is strength and trusting one another to achieve their goals."

Verrado returned just two varsity players but still finished 13-1. It lost its season opener to 6A Mountain Ridge but hasn't lost since. Seniors No. 1 Faith Grabau, No. 2 Gisele Wilkinson and No. 3 Ella Klein have led the way. "Faith has been in the program for three years and has improved significantly in her game play and skills," coach Candice Wadding said. "Faith is always ready for a challenge and leads her team through her leadership and excellent sportsmanship. Gisele has also been in the program for three years. She is a leader for her team and has played an instrumental role in guiding the rest of the varsity team to develop into the players they are today. Ella has improved each match throughout the season. Her athleticism and hard work have led her to an overall record of 10-3 while she continues to be a vital player on our team." Second year player Elizabeth Naylor and first year player Brianna Baldenegro have also played important roles for the Phoenix Region champs.

Arizona College Prep's Patience Ferry is a first-year coach who guided her program to the East Valley Region title. Ferry has been a track throws coach for almost a decade. With more players joining the program this season, the program had to make some adjustments. "We overcame this obstacle by communicating and promoting a supportive environment for all members," Ferry said. The team's MVPs are Suri Bai, Anagha Gupta, Olivia Kurniawan, Yashica Raghavendra, and Tanvi Anand. "These players have some of the best technical skills on our courts," coach said. "If we make the playoffs, we will owe it to the immense amount of hard work our upperclassmen have put into our varsity lineup. From running drills to reinforcing proper techniques, we've been able to compete at a higher level of excellence." JV players Amelia Tan, Chloe Lee, Navya Nanthakumar, and Sahana Aleti are making valuable contibuting behind the scenes. "These JV players have been at practice, helping to ensure we start on time, setting an excellent example and having a positive attitude that bolster the team's morale," coach said.

Central finished the regular season with a 13-1 mark. That last time it won that many team matches was in 2019. The Bobcats are winning despite having three new varsity members and two new doubles teams. our athletes rose to the challenge," coach Monique Dumar said. "We found our rhythm, built strong chemistry, and turned those early obstacles into strengths. What's even more impressive, our team is full of scholars — students balancing honors courses, leadership roles, clubs, and badminton and still showing up every day ready to compete." Dumar made sure to mention the training her team received at the Arizona Badminton Center played a big role in elevating her team physically and mentally. The undefeated doubles team of Symone McClure and Trang Tran, who have dropped only two games this year, are Central's leaders. "They have been nothing short of phenomenal," Dumar said. "They've spent the last three years building trust, communication, and confidence together. Watching them this year has been a masterclass in teamwork, strategy, and grit — the perfect way to cap off their senior season." Central's No. 4, Sara Mendoza, is only a sophomore but is a tone setter in practice for the squad, coach added. "She is hardworking, humble and hungry to improve," Dumar said. "Sara has grown tremendously this season, showing composure under pressure and proving that the future of Central badminton is bright." Three seasons ago, Central had a 4-10 record. "Fast forward to today, and we're a playoff-contending team built on determination, laughter, and a shared belief that growth takes time and teamwork," Dumar said. "This journey has been about more than wins — it's been about building a legacy."

Marcos de Niza overcame some health issues in the early going but once healthy the Padres completed an 11-3 regular season. It's only the second time the program has won more than 10 matches in a season in the past decade. Four of the players have been with the program throughout their high school careers and two of them are three-year badminton players. Samantha Schneider, Bella Johnson, Jaana Parmelee, and Mia Gault have each pulled their weight while leading the team, coach Claudia Ramirez said. "No. 5 Mallory Zino and No. 6 Kayden Wilson have really come in clutch to secure single and doubles wins at times when my higher ranked players weren't performing at their best," Ramirez added. "I have full confidence in them to pull their weight when it matters most."

Thunderbird graduated eight seniors last year and played a tough schedule but still landed a postseason bid for the third consecutive season. "We are definitely not in the same division (as some of the D-I teams we played) for a reason, but this year my girls took those games as a learning opportunity," coach Kelly Pavlik said. "They learned from the better players and therefore became better as a team." Senior Siena Rounds, one of only two seniors in the team's top-6, is having an MVP-type season for her team. Junior Lilanie Granados Flores is a role player who always seems to make the right adjustments and elevate the play of her doubles partner. "My girls have continued to put in the time to get better," Pavlik said.
